### **Recent Updates**

The Syrian Warplanes targeted Khan Al Shieh eastern vicinity with 4 explosive barrels, and the Syrian Regime artillery targeted Al Khan area in the western side of the camp with a tank round, where the opposition targeted the Regime forces centered on Al Salam Highway which prevailed panic amongst the residents fearing the bombing reaches their camp and being victims of Syrian Forces revenge.

All roads in Khan Al Sheih camp that connect the camp with Damascus are still closed except Zakia-Khan Al Shieh road, where residents are obliged to go through it though the risks that they might face such as bombing and sniping, which led to the death of many people from the camp. AGPS documented 137 victims amongst residents of Khan Al Sheih camp who died since the beginning of the war in Syria.

In the south of Damascus, news from Yarmouk camp reported that Al Nusra Front executed Hmeda Jallad, a mother for 4 children, near Palestine mosque in charges of insulting God for several times. It is noted that it is not the first time for Al Nusra Front to execute people in the

camp. AGPS was not able to make sure of the news till this moment. ISIS and Al Nusra Front continue control the Yarmouk camp since the beginning of April 2015, and they are imposing their own special agendas on the besieged people. It is noted that activists accused ISIS and Al Nusra Front of assassinating activists and relief workers in the camp.

On the other hand, PLO and Jafra organization started to distribute a new patch of humanitarian aid to the displaced residents of Yarmouk camp in Yelda, Bebla, and Bait Sahem; the aid included food and hygiene parcels, in addition to disinfection pills, as the distribution process will last for four consecutive days.

In a related context, the International Relief Organization in cooperation with the Charity Commission visited Saed Al Ass School at Al Ayans area in Al Ameen Al Demashqi neighborhood and Abdel Qader Al Husaini School at Al Afeef neighborhood in Damascus. They presented school bags and winter blankets to the students of the two schools; however, they

insured that 150 female and male students got school bags and winter blankets in the two schools from Yarmouk residents.

I is referred that the Palestinian camps specially the displaced residents of the camps are suffering from difficult living situations due to the rising prices, weak of financial resources and the spread of unemployment because of the ongoing war in Syria and the Syrian Army and PFGC continuation to prevent the residents to return back to their houses, in addition to the control of ISIS and Al Nusra front over the camp, which caused displacement of thousands of residents from the camp.

The Palestinian refugee Essam Al Am Ali "Abu Ali" left the Yarmouk camp the day before to get treatment in Damascus after the agreement of the Syrian Security, which prevents the besieged people of Yarmouk or the adjacent areas to get out of the area because the Army considers them as part of the Opposition except old people and patients.

In Damascus Suburb, a satisfaction state prevailed Khan Danoun camp in Damascus Suburb after signing the truce between the Regular Army and the Military Syrian Opposition in Al Tiba village surrounding the camp after the camp was a clashing area. As a result to the truce, the road between the camp and the village was opened which was closed since more than a year, the earthen walls were erased and the residents returned back to the village which was under the military Opposition forces through the opened road. The residents of the camp suffer from water cut where they are forced to buy drinking water through mobile tanks which increased the economic burdens. The Ministry of Irrigation ordered to distribute water to the camp and lanes that don't have water with 6 water tanks a day for free or a symbolic price.

In a different context, a number of Daraa activists and families accused the Jordanian Army of preventing to enter the wounded Palestinian refugees and assisting the wounded including women and children. Eye witnesses said that after bombing Daraa camp and Al Muzareeb compound for Palestinian refugees by the Regular Army that resulted in a number of dead and wounded refugees, the Jordanian Army prevent the entry of wounded Palestinians to Jordan for several times when they reach the earthen wall between Syria and Jordan.

### **Europe**

The ministers of interior in the European Union decided during the meeting today, after intensive discussions, to distribute 120000 refugees on the European countries according to the shares system. The decision came as a result to the refugees flows to the European Union countries and the Hungarian bad treatment for the refugees crossing its borders.



The Croatian Red Cross declared that about 5400 refugees reached Croatia in the last 24 hours after Hungary closed its borders in the faces


of refugees, where buses drop them in Serbia near the borders between two countries then they cross to Croatia and Slovenia then to Austria.

It is mentioned that hundreds of Palestinian Syrian Refugees continue their trip to the European countries through Greece till the European Asylum countries. Dozens of refugees enter Austria and Germany each day, where others continue to the Scandinavian countries. It is noted that more than 36000 Palestinian Syrian refugees reached Europe during the last four years.

### **Turkey**

The Palestinians of Syria Committee in Turkey distributes Eid clothes to the displaced Palestinian refugee's children, who escaped the war in Syria and were settled in Kilis Turkish state, to draw the smile on children's faces. It is referred that the Palestinians of Syria in Turkey suffer from living difficulties especially with the rising rents and difficulties to get work.

The unofficial statistics refer to that there are about 300 to 5000 Palestinian Syrian refugee in Turkey though Turkey is a transit country for many Palestinian refugees heading to the European countries.

#### Numbers and Statistics till 22/9/2015

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 812 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 882 days, water was cut for 372 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 674 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 875 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 519 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
