RECENT UPDATES

Sporadic clashes erupted in Al-Orouba Street in Al-Yarmouk Camp between the two groups of ISIS and Al-Nusra Front who control the camp for the time being. The camp's streets and neighborhoods witnessed a state of security tension as armed members of the two groups spread everywhere, activists assured.



On the other hand, news from inside the camp confirmed that Al-Nusra Front has arrested two members of Fateh Palestinian Movement "Bahaa Al-Amin" and "Samer Shalabi" on charges of spying for the interest of Assad's regime and its affiliated PFLP-GC militias.

The camp houses, previously, had been hit by mortar shelling on Al-Ja'ouna neighborhood which caused material damages only.

These incidents come in light of repetitive rumors regarding secretly signed agreement between ISIS and Assad's regime indicates complete withdrawal from the camp and handing over heavy weapons to the

regime, in return the regime will secure safe route for ISIS towards Al-Raqqa City north of Syria.

It should be remembered also, that Al-Nusra Front had facilitated the way for ISIS to break into the Yarmouk Camp back in April 2015.

In Damascus Suburb, many activists called for the civilians not to cross Khan Eshieh – Zakiya road or to take full cautious since it could be very dangerous as the regime is still targeting it on semi-daily basis.



Khan Eshieh – Zakiya road considered to be the last artery to feed the camp with foods and basic goods, people of the camp feel obliged to cross it though it could be very dangerous to the extent they named it as "Death Road".

In a different topic, the Syrian regime is still arresting three brothers from "Al-Taamari" family in its prisons for two years, they are "Khaled Jamal Al-Taamary" 26-years-old, "Mohammad Jamal Al-Taamary" 23-years-old, and "Ahmad Jamal Al-Taamary" 19-years-old. All of them were arrested in 1 May 2014 at Ali Alwahsh Checkpoint while leaving the Yarmouk Camp, at that time, the Assad Regime spreaded rumors about

allowing humanitarian corridor to let civilians out of the camp, but instead, hundreds were missed that day and still unaccounted for until now.

It should be mentioned that the AGPS receives hundreds of letters from families of missed and prisoned Palestinians to be documented and to reveal their fate to public by the Assad Regime, this data is being processed despite of the difficulties as the regime keeps reticent about their fate.

The AGPS managed to document 1044 Palestinian arrestees in Assad's prisons including 75 females, while 431 were tortured to death.



Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon distributed heating fuel of Diesel to about 200 needy families in Al-Jalil Camp in Lebanon.

It is noteworthy that around 42,500 Palestinian-Syrians who had fled Syria to Lebanon live in harsh living conditions and suffer from the lack of employment and the high prices in addition to the fluctuating legal status.

Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics until 23 January 2016

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 42,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- More than 71,200 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe until the end of December 2015.
- The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command), continued for 924 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 1013 days, water cut for 502 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 185 victims.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 808 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 1001 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: Running water cut continues for 662 days, and 70% of its buildings were distroyed.
- Jarmana, AL-SaiedaZainab, Al-Raml, Al-Aedein Homs and AedeinHama: A relatively quiet situations in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia-Khan EShieh road.
