### Latest Developments

ISIS targeted Tahrir AlSham-led zones in western Yarmouk Camp for Palestinian refugees with mortar shells. As a result, wildfires broke out at a civilian home in Eilout Street.

Reporting from Yarmouk, AGPS news correspondent said fierce clashes between ISIS and Tahrir AlSham flared up at the crossroads to Street 15. Three ISIS fighters were pronounced dead in the clashes.



At the same time, ISIS snipers gunned down two Tahrir AlSham fighters at a flashpoint near western Yarmouk, seriously wounding one of them.

A member of Aknaf Beit AlMaqdis battalion also sustained wounds near Palestine Street after he was shot by an ISIS sniper. Government reconnaissance drones kept, meanwhile, hovering over the territory.

In the meantime, pro-government sources said the first batch of ISIS fighters in AlHajar AlAswad, near Yarmouk Camp, have retreated to AlRiqa. Activists denied the piece of news.

A couple of days earlier, two sick members of Tahrir AlSham were allowed access out of besieged Yarmouk in exchange for the retreat of two persons from AlFou'a and Kafriya, north of Syria.

Clashes between ISIS and Tahrir AlSham have rocked Yarmouk Camp since April 6, 2016.

In another development, the Syrian government forces struck on Friday Daraa Camp and AlSadd Road with barrel bombs and surface-to-surface missiles, resulting in heavy material damage. Live snapshots circulated on social media showed the mounds of rubble into which civilian homes and structures were turned in the raging warfare.



12 members of the pro-government Fourth Division were pronounced dead after they were chased down by the opposition outfits near Daraa Camp and refused to turn themselves in.

Over recent weeks, clashes between the regime troops and the opposition battalions have reached a zenith in southern Syria as both sides have strived to capture Daraa province.

#### Civil Action Committees

As part of its Joy of Eid campaign, the Palestine Charity Commission, in partnership with Shourouq AlShams Foundation, distributed in-kind and cash aids to 50 orphans in AlMuzeireeb.

Palestinian refugees in Daraa have been grappling with dire conditions due to the unabated hostilities and permanent power and water blackouts rocking the area.



### Palestinians of Syria: June 23, 2017 Statistics:

- At least 3,521 Palestinians, including 463 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.
- 1,612 Palestinian refugees, including 100 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.
- Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,430 days in a row.
- 196 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.

- Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,166 and 1,017 days.
- Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,510 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 244 days.
- Nearly 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until the end of 2016.
- 31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.
- 17,000 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.
- 6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.
- 8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.
- 1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.
