## **Victims:**

Zakaria Mawed “Abu Yehia,” leader in the “Aknafe Beit Al-Maqdes” battalion, has died yesterday by a sniper shot from ISIS, during fighting on the front of the Japanese hospital in Yarmouk camp, between the armed Syrian opposition factions and ISIS.



## **Latest Developments:**

AGPS’s correspondent has confirmed that ISIS targeted the armed Syrian opposition’s points at the axis of the clinic and the Japanese hospital located on the outskirts of Yarmouk camp, using poisonous gas bombs. Dozens of fighters in the ranks of the “Aknafe Beit Al-Maqdes” battalion were injured and taken to the field hospital in Yelda, south of Damascus.

A medical source in Yelda said that the symptoms of gas poisoning are shortness of breath and bronchospasm as well as severe watery eyes. The source clarified that the gas used was possibly chlorine gas.

Activists accused the Syrian regime and its affiliated factions in south Damascus of providing ISIS with poisonous gases, pointing out that the battle that occurred on the border of the camp with the town of Yelda and the opposition closing the barrier between them was a result of “An implicit condition imposed by the regime forces on the opposition forces in the towns of Yelda, Babilla and Beit Sahm in return for entering an agreement to reduce tension with Russia, or facilitating the control of Irani militias in the region.”



In the same context, AGPS’s correspondent said that violent clashes broke out yesterday after ISIS tried to control the clinic next to the Japanese Hospital. “Aknaf Beit Al-Maqdes” fighters and the Syrian opposition factions (Jaish Al-Ababeel, Jaish Al-Islam and Sham Al-Rasoul battalions) prevented the intrusion attempt and killed a number of ISIS members.

Our reporter confirmed that after taking control of Al-ezz Ibn Abd Al-Salam School two days ago, ISIS returned in full power to take control of the clinic point which is at the entrance of the Japanese

hospital, for it being a strategic location overlooking the wide areas of Yelda, monitoring civilians' houses and having vital roads.

The Syrian regime and its affiliated Palestinian factions bombarded a number of different areas in Yarmouk camp using mortar shells, causing destruction to the residents' houses and creating fear among them.

In the meantime, the Syrian security released Palestinian "Samer Abd Al-Hameed" from Neirab camp in Aleppo, after he was detained in the city more than 20 days ago.

The Syrian security continues to detain 1640 Palestinians, according to AGPS's statistics. 97 of the detained are residents of Neirab camp. Their fates remain mysterious. The number of detained refugees is believed to be much higher.

In Lebanon, the "Amany for Relief and Medical Care" charity announced the arrival of a French doctor specialized in chest diseases, asthma, sensitivity and lungs on Wednesday and Thursday 2nd and 3rd of November 2017.

The charity added that the check up will be free, in addition to the medication provided by the center, adding that the displaced Syrian people from Beddawi and Al-Bared camps are included in the treatment program.

Unofficial statistics have indicated the decrease of the number of Palestinian refugees in Lebanon to 31 thousand.

In another context, the refugees using the crossing between Turkey and Bulgaria are using stairs to pass illegally over the border fence

between the two countries that was set up by the Bulgarian authorities to prevent the entrance of refugees.

The Bulgarian media reported that the authorities accused the refugees of digging tunnels under the barrier, expressing the concern of the officials that the border fence did not deter refugees and migrants from accessing the Bulgarian territory.

The flow of migration on the Turkish-Bulgarian border has increased again in recent weeks.

Bulgaria is considered one of the European transit countries, through which thousands of Palestinian-Syrian refugees crossed in an attempt to reach European countries of asylum.



### **Palestinians of Syria: October 23, 2017 Statistics:**

- The total number of victims documented by the Action Group is 3603, including 462 Women 1640 Palestinians are locked up behind Syrian government's bars, 105 of which are women
- Yarmouk refugee camp is under the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine's siege for 1,559 days in a row 200 refugees, mainly in Yarmouk Camp, have

died due to lack of medical care and malnutrition Water supplies have been cut off Deraa Camp for 1296 days, and 1136 days in Yarmouk Camp

- Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo have been banned from their homes for 1,632 days. Government troops have taken over the camp for more than 383 days.
- Approximately 85 thousand Palestinian-Syrian refugees fled to Europe by the end of 2016
- 31 thousand refugees are located in Lebanon
- 17 thousand refugees are sheltered in Jordan
- 6 thousand refugees are in Egypt
- 8 thousand refugees are staying in Turkey
- One thousand refugees are present in Gaza
