Recent Updates

The remaining residents of Daraa Camp southern of Syria are complaining of the continuous water crisis for 193 days respectively, while people were forced to use water wells to secure their needs. This crisis coincided with the power cut for very long periods in addition to the absence of medical services due to the massive destruction to the houses of the camp.

Unofficial statistics indicates that 70% of the camps' houses were completely demolished including many pharmacies 'clinics, and UNRWA buildings. The camp was targeted recently during the past few months repeatedly with many kinds of shills and explosive barrels, In addition to the heavy clashes that broke out in the neighborhoods and adjacent areas, which forced the residents to flee of the camp escaping of the repeated bombing and the difficulty of living.

In Germany, a number of Palestinian Syrian and Syrian refugees who escaped from the hell of the Syrian war searching for safety and security, are suffering of miserable conditions in Germany, since a number of them are sleeping in the open in a military barracks at "Bayern" province north of Munich, which is characterized by its coldly weather.

The Federal Office for Migration and Refugees in Germany anticipated to receive 175,000 asylum applications in 2014, while the office said that in the first nine months of 2014, 116.659 refugees were recorded, in addition to twenty thousand refugees were received officially in Germany, it is noteworthy that this number has doubled more than 57% from the same period in 2013. While Germany is expected to receive officially in this year 10,000 refugees who have families in Germany and applied for reunion.

Returning to Syria, warplanes hovered above Khan AL Shieh Camp in Damascus city, coincided with bombing targeted the adjacent farms with heavy artillery shells which led to a state of fear and panic amongst the residents who are suffering of economic crises due to the closure of the roads that link the cap to the city center except for Zakia-Khan AL Shieh road despite its risk.



On the other hand, "UNRWA" has managed, for the second day respectively, to enter limited quantities of food aid to the Yarmouk Camp after the Regular Army barriers and groups of the PFGC allowed them to do so. Those barriers preventing the entry of any food or essential supplies to the camp since "476" days with the exception of allowing some relief agencies to enter limited amounts of aid between now and then, that is not enough for the besieged residents.

It is mentions that 155 refugees were killed due to the strict siege imposed on the camp due to malnutrition and lack of Medical care.

In Aleppo, "Ahmad Walid Abdul Haq" has been released after a group affiliated with the Syrian opposition arrested him because of his relationship with the regular army, where it was reported that he has been released after the announcement of disowned and repented of his relationship with Al Quds brigade which is affiliated to the regular army.

Civil Work Committees

The International Campaign "Onsur-Nabd AL Hayat Convoy4" has distributed food aids to 500 Palestinian Syrian families at Ain AL Hilwa Camp in Sidon city in Lebanon. Ain AL Hilwa camp is receiving hundreds of Palestinian Syrian families who were fled of Syria due to the siege and bombing.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics :

- The Yarmouk Camp: - The Continuance of the siege by the Regular Army and PFGC for the 476 respectively in addition to the power cut for more than 559 days and the water cut for 46 days respectively. The number of the siege victims is 155 victims.*
- Al Husayneyya Camp: - The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the 378 days respectively.*



- *Al Sbeina Camp: - The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the 347days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp:-The residents left the camp since 547 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled the camp.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - Almost 193 days without water and a complete absence of basic services.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - the roads that linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for the Zakia road.*
- *Khan Danoun Camp: - economic crises continue, specially the unemployment and the high prices .*
- *Al Nairab Camp: - the power is still cut for more than a year.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - relative calm situation in light of the economic crises.*
