Recent Updates

Wide security campaign was implemented in Al Aedein camp by dozens of Syrian security forces, yesterday, began with crossfire between Syrian security forces and a number of armed youths in the Western of "Nissan" Hospital, accompanied by sounds of explosions by mortars that targeted the camp and its surroundings.

Our correspondent reported that the clashes broke out after an attempt of the Syrian security patrols to raid the home of the wanted young man "Wisam Al Sayed" known as Abu Mohammed. The young man is one those who settled their status with the Syrian security services in coordination with the Palestinian factions. Our correspondent also reported that there were crowds of the Syrian security forces in the western vicinity of the camp, coincided with a number of snipers and members of the security forces who were based on the surfaces of the rooms in the University City, adjacent to the camp.

As the campaign provoked a state of panic amongst the residents who rushed to bring their children from schools, to close their shop and stay in their homes for fear of being shot or arrested

It is noteworthy that the AGPS documented the names of 123 prisoners from Al Aedin cam in Homs.

In Damascus, violent clashes broke out yesterday evening in the Yarmouk refugee camp, at the center of Palestine and Al Thalathein Streets between the Syrian army alongside with Palestinian groups loyal to it and armed opposition groups, coincided with several artillery shells were dropped on Al Thalathein and Rama Streets with no injuries.

On the other hand, the Democratic Front for the Liberation of Palestine in the Yarmouk camp revived its 46 anniversary, where it organized a rhetorically festival attended by a number of representatives of the factions in the Yarmouk refugee camp in addition to a number of residents.

The Yarmouk refugee camp

The Yarmouk refugee camp is still besieged by the Syrian army and the Popular Front - General Command for (598) days respectively, which led to the death of (167) victims because of malnutrition and medical care shortage.

In terms of the economic aspect, the residents of AL Nairab camp In Aleppo are suffering of the high prices of food supplies, the scarcity of fuel, and the frequent power cut, forcing them to buy the power form the owners of the private generators. The suffering of the residents increased within the low temperature, especially after the loss of fuel, forcing them to use the firewood and the remains of trees for heating. It is mentioned that the one ton price of firewood has reached 200\$, as the gas cylinder price, if it was available, reached to 50\$.

The camp is witnessing a state of instability and insecure due to the deterioration of the security situation in the surrounding places, and due to the involvement of some residents in the fighting alongside with Syrian army, the thing that made the camp vulnerable to shelling that targeted different places of it and resulted in many victims and injuries.

In Turkey, Al Wafaa European campaign opened Al Wafaa temporary Shelter center for the Palestinian refugees south of Turkey yesterday morning. The campaign noted that the aim of opening this center is trying to secure temporary shelter to receive the new displaced refugees until they manage to settle their situation and determine their destination.

It is mentioned that the center was opened during the arrival of Al Wafaa European campaign delegation to Turkey three days ago. The supervisors of the campaign carried out field visits to many towns and cities in the south of Turkey. The convoy distributed some relief aid to the displaced

families there. It is mentioned that there is no official statistics about the number of the Palestinian refugees in Turkey, but the estimations indicated that there are 3000-5000 Palestinian refugees in Turkey.



Civil Work Committees

Palestine Charity Committee distributed about 90 food meals to some families in the besieged Yarmouk Camp in Damascus in an attempt to alleviate the suffering of its residents.

Meanwhile, the Charity Committee for the Relief of the Palestinian People honored some students of Al Amal kindergarten in the Yarmouk camp, within its efforts to alleviate the psychological pressure of the besieged children inside the camp.

Numbers and Statistics till 24/2/2015:-

- At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- 2663 Palestinian refugee victims were documented by the AGPS.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 598 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 678 days, water was cut for 168 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 167 victims.
- 80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51,300 in Lebanon and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 500 days respectively.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 469 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 671 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 315 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
