### "Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon Demand UNRWA to Undo its Unfair Decisions

#### Lebanon


Displaced Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon demanded UNRWA to cancel its decision of reducing cash assistance provided to them, and vowed to escalate their protests that they started with set-ins and storming some UNRWA schools, to reach its peak, which no one can be expected its results.

According to a refugee who reported to the AGPS correspondent in Lebanon that UNRWA invoked every time under false pretenses to cut off financial aid to the Palestinians of Syria. He also added that the Palestinian refugee has been rejected everywhere, especially in light of the real suffering that they live in Lebanon, which is arbitrary actions taken by the Lebanese government against them, the non-renewal of residency, to prevent them from entering Lebanese territory, in addition to depriving them of their rights as refugees.

It was mentioned that UNRWA announced that it will cut the amount of 150,000LL, equivalent to \$ 100 a month starting from July 2015, which was paid for more than 43,000displacedPalestinians from Syria to Lebanon as shelter allowance for them.

#### **Victims**

Four Palestinian refugees were killed in Syria, including two victims shot dead by Syrian security, while the third died under torture, and the fourth died by the bombing. The victims are:

The two refugees "Tariq Ismail Mohammed" and "Muhannad Khaled Mohammed" from KhanAl Shieh Palestinian refugee camp in Damascus suburb. They were shot by a Syrian security member near their home in Jaramana.

According to one of the activists that one of the security members who is on the regular army checkpoint in the town chased them after they had an argument, and then he shot the two of them dead immediately.

The refugee "Mohammed Salah Al Hashem," 22 years from Khan Al Shieh Palestinian refugee camp in Damascus suburb died under torture in the prisons of the Syrian regime. It was mentioned that his family received the news of his death inside the prison by one of the detainees who were released earlier.

Meanwhile, the refugee "Arafat Sayed Al Qudairi," a field commander of Yarmouk Martyrs Brigade in the western region of Hauran, also died following clashes between groups of Yarmouk Martyrs Brigade, affiliated to the Syrian armed opposition, and the members of Al Nusra Front.

In a related context 13 Palestinian refugees from Yarmouk died since the beginning of May 2015, including 9 of them died due to clashes and shelling, a refugee died as a result of lack of medical care, another refugee died in mysterious circumstances, and two refugees died due to torture in Syrian prisons.

It should be noted that the AGPS documented the names of more than 1,100 victims from the Yarmouk refugee camp who died since the beginning of the war in Syria.

#### Recent Updates

Bombing targeted separate areas in the Yarmouk camp in Damascus yesterday, coincided with clashes on several points in the camp such as Al Thalatheen Street crossing. The Yarmouk also witnesses a tension state and absence of relief work due to the withdrawal of all relief activists from the camp because of the ISIS incursion to the camp at the beginning of April 2015 fearing for their lives.

It is worthy to mention that the Regular Army and PFGC are imposing a strict siege on the Yarmouk camp since more than 696 days. Horror and panic state was spread amongst Khan Al Shieh residents due to the continuation of heavy bombing with explosive barrels and artillery shells, which led to the death of at least two victims and a number of wounded civilians including children.

It was mentioned that all roads connecting the camp with Damascus the capital are completely closed except Zakia-Khan Al Sheh road which is targeted by the Regular Army with machine guns and shells once in a while. In Aleppo, violent clashes broke out near Azeeza and Shekh Lutfi fronts which surround Al Nairab camp for Palestinian refugees, where fire shooting sounds were heard clearly in the camp between the Opposition forces and the Regular Army.

On the other hand, unofficial statistics referred that 70% of the houses and building of Der'aa camp for Palestinian refugees Southern of Syria were damaged due to the continuous targeting to separate areas of the camp with bombing and shells. The remaining people of the camp are

living in dangerous humanitarian situation manifested with the living and health sides. In terms of health, a number of activists renewed their warning from the spread of diseases amongst the residents especially where they are obliged to drink from the polluted water due to the water cut for more than 403 days.

#### Numbers and Statistics till 24/5/2015

- Thousands of Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.
- At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The number of Palestinian detainees who were documented by the AGPS has reached 869 detainees, and 391 victims were killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 696 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 766 days, water was cut for 256 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 177 victims.
- 80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51,300 in Lebanon and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.

- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 577 days respectively.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 558 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 760 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 403 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
