#### **Victims**

Four Palestinian victims were killed in Syria yesterday, where doctor "Mahmoud Hamarna", from Yarmouk, and the young man, "Suleiman Ahmed Tamim," was born in 1983 were killed due to torture in the prisons of the Syrian regime, bringing the number of victims of torture, during August, to 25 victims.

As the professor, "Mohammed Mizel" from Dara'a camp was killed and his son Ibrahim was wounded, after being targeted by snipers of the Syrian Regular Army at Muftrh checkpoint Dara'a - Muzeireeb road, and states that their family had been displaced from Dara'a camp after the Syrian Regular Army targeted the camp with explosive barrels and snipping actions.

Meanwhile, the young man, "Saleh Saud Salman" was killed due to the ongoing clashes between the Syrian Regime forces along side with Palestinian groups loyal to it and the opposition groups at Palestine Street at the Yarmouk camp entrance. The young man is one of the cadres of the PFLP-General Command; one of the Palestinian groups fighting alongside the Syrian regime.

## **Recent Updates**

A number of mortar shells targeted the Yarmouk camp in Damascus for the second day respectively, which targeted different parts of it, while clashes broke out between members of the regular army along side with groups of the Popular Front - General Command and the opposition groups near Palestine Street. The clashes led to the death of a member of the Popular Front and this tension resulted in the stop of aid distribution to the people who are trapped for more than a year.

The Syrian security forces arrested the headmaster of Abdul-Qader al-Husseini school, during his exit to the entrance of the camp near the point of food aid distribution at Al Righa yard, it is noted that he supervised the education of the secondary school students, and made great efforts for that, inside the besieged camp until the students are able to get out of the camp to perform the examinations.

Meanwhile, a state of careful quite prevailed Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus city coincided with sounds of explosions caused by the bombing of neighboring areas with a number of shells.

On the other hand, members of the Syrian security forces and factions loyal to arrested the student "Moamen Jawhar" from Al Nairab camp in Aleppo during his return from the University of Aleppo, it is referred that the camp is under the full control of the regular army and Palestinian factions loyal to it. The camp is considered an important strategic point because of it is close to the Neirab military airport.

People of Al Raml camp complain of unemployment widespread in their camp, especially with rising food prices and the high cost of rents houses.
