Recent Updates

The AGPS correspondent reported that a six-month baby (Omar Abo Hamda) has been killed and at least 12 people were wounded in an artillery shelling on Khan Al Shieh Refugee Camp in Damascus Suburb. The shelling targeted the western neighborhood and the only clinic in the camp, where many



people were trying to vaccinate their children. He added, "Heavy clashes broke out between the armed opposition groups and the Syrian Army"

The artillery shelling was renewed yesterday afternoon where many mortar shells targeted Al-Thanwya Street causing many injuries among children, in addition to an old man and his wife who were injured at the old Market. A third mortar shell targeted the main street in front of Al khawaled neighborhood in an agricultural land causing no injuries or causalities.

The Syrian Air Forces target Khan Al Shieh Camp in West Ghout in Damascus almost daily causing deaths and injuries among civilian displaced people. The camp is one of the biggest Palestinian refugee camps. About 12 thousand people live in the camp, in addition to hundreds of displaced people fleeing from towns and cities of Al-Ghouta such as Muadamiyat Al-Sham and Darya because of the deteriorated security situation there. All roads leading to the camp are closed except Zakia Road which is always under attack and shooting that results in many deaths.

The Syrian Army targeted Southern Syria mainly "Deraa" and "Al-Sad Street" with land-to-land Fel-Missile in which many Palestinian refugees and displaced people live – with– Land Surface Missile- and Mortar Shells.

People in Deraa Camp suffer from frequent airstrikes and clashes which damage 70% of its building -according to unofficial survey.

AGPS documented, 339 of Palestinian refugees were killed in Deraa, and most of the other refuges live in serious conditions in both health and living sides, and shortage of water in the camp since 752 days.

In northern Syria, People in Al-Nairab Camp - as well as the other Palestinian camps in Syria –suffer from the high prices, heating, flour and the greedy traders who monopolize the food and then re-buy it with high prices which increase their suffering. Camp residents called those traders to stop using the bad conditions that they live in.

However, people in the camp suffer from the shortage of electricity and telecommunications for long period and they are afraid of continuous raised prices and the devaluation of the Syrian pound to the dollar and the lack of financial resource, and the spread of unemployment among the people of the camp which would negatively affect their poor living conditions as a result of the ongoing war on Syria.



Civil Work Committees

Within -Rajeen Campaign- and after the census carried out by the Commission for relief work, Jafra Foundation for Relief and Development continued to distribute food baskets to the displaced families of Yarmok refugee camp.

For the Yarmok refugee camp people, In the beginning of April Daash in corporation with Al-Nusra Front broke into the Yarmok refugee camp, so that hundreds of Palestinian families were displaced from the camp.

It is reported that most of the relief organizations working in Yarmouk camp suspended its activities after being threatened by Daash which is accused of assassinating a number of activists in the camp.



Jordan

In Cybercity in Jordan, Palestinian refugees suffer from miserable humanitarian situation because of the negligence of international organizations and human rights organizations, where it is recently recorded about 175 Palestinian families escaped from Syria because of the ongoing war.

People in Cybercity live harsh life, most of families have more than 5 members, every family have only one room, the whole rooms in the floor have one kitchen and one bathroom used by everyone, add to this, the restrictions imposed on the refugee especially the Palestinians who have the Syrian ID which led them to commit suicide to escape the miserable life.

A refugee says that the Jordanian authorities' treatment was insulting. He adds, although there are many people who carry the Jordanian passport, they treated us as suspects just because we are Palestinian"

Also he states" here in Cybercity we are not allowed to visit our relatives and must not go out as we are in Guantanamo".

It is worth mentioning that this industrial park, which turned into a detention center surrounded by a high fence and heavily guarded also it is under the supervision of several Jordanian security services, it is originally the residence of Asian workers who were employed in the industrial factories in Irbid city before it is closed years ago as a result of protest against poor level of housing

Sweden

The Palestinian refugee "Ahmed Sabaa Abd-Alhafez" who emigrated from the Yarmok camp to Sweden won the International Stavanger Chess Championship in Sweden which took place in Stavanger City in Norway; Hafez got the title after beating many professional players.

It is noteworthy that many of the Syrian-Palestinian professionals, academics and the graduates of universities are trying to make their way in the Diaspora countries after fleeing the war in Syria, and as a result of bombardments and shelling on their camps whereas more than 71.2 thousand of Palestinian refugees arrived to Europe the last December and immigration is still on going.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 25\04\2016:

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon
- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached
 Europe till the End of December 2015
- 8000 Palestinians of Syria Refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinians of Syria Refugees are in Gaza Strip
- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1045 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1106 days, water was cut for 595 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 186.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 900days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1093 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 753 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
