Victims

Three Palestinian Syrian refugees died, including (Shadi Hassan Helal) who was tortured to death in the prisons of the Syrian regime after being detained for more than 2 years.

It is noteworthy that, the AGPS documented earlier 448 Palestinian victims who died due to torture, including women, children, and elderly.

The Palestinian refugee, Basel Khalefa, from Jaramana camp, died of his wounds after a mortar shell fell on Qamar Alsham restaurant in Bab Toma area which raises the number of the Palestinian victims who died due to bombing to 1096 since the beginning of the war in Syria.

A number of mortar shells targeted the old Damascus city, Bab Toma, Abo Romana, Almoza area, Osh Alwerwer and Al Abbasseen the day after yesterday resulting in 8 deaths and 24 injuries.

In Lebanon, the Palestinian refugee, Khaled Naser Abojeda, died of his wounds after being shot while moving from a neighborhood to another in Meia Meia camp at Sidon city in Lebanon.

The Palestinian Security forces confirmed that they arrested 3 suspects and handed them to the Lebanese army in the south. According to these resources, the suspects are: Hamza S, Mostfa h, and Qassem SH, while the initial investigations conducted by the Palestinian security forces suggest that the crime was due to a political background.

Recent Updates

Deraa Camp for Palestinian refugees was targeted by anti-aircraft artillery on Sunday night causing serious damage in properties which deepen the suffering of the refugees in the camp due to the lack of health and relief aids for more than 2 years.

70% of the camp's buildings were completely and partially destroyed due to the repeated bombing that targeted the camp, where all kinds of explosive barrels and shells were used.

In the besieged Yarmouk Camp, members of ISIS lashed a young man for adultery, while pictures on Facebook and social media showed one of ISIS members carrying a banner in front of a big crowed of besieged civilians in Yarmouk, including children, with a state written on it (the punishment is 100 lashes) for the unmarried person.

ISIS committed many violations against civilians after imposing control backed and supported by Nusra front over the Yarmouk camp on 1 / April / 2015.

UNRWA re-called the international community for finance for the Palestinian Syrian refugees; UNRWA said on its website that, its capacity to continue is under threat, as the emergency appeal of Syrian crisis 2016 is still suffering from a severe lack of funding, noting that only 30% of the needed finance were collected.

UNRWA assured that the situation is still very difficult for the Palestinian refugee and Syrian as well, and the armed violence still affects a wider area of Syria where people live in dire conditions, while the effects of the conflict could be seen even in the parts that were not directly affected by the armed violence.

In addition, violence has led to a collective displacement of almost 60% of the Palestinian community, while economic has deteriorated sharply which led to rampant inflation and high rate of unemployment estimated with about 57%. More than 70% of UNRWA schools were destroyed or partially damaged.

UNRWA mentioned that it gives humanitarian aid such as food and non-food, cash money, communal homes, and providing essential services such as educating about 45000 students, and health care through 26 health centers and points, and many services including physical rehabilitation and literacy courses for adults and psychosocial support.

At the end of its appeal, UNRWA stressed that the international community should fulfill its obligations towards the Palestinian refugees, particularly those who are in Syria, it should be given the support to do so.

It is noteworthy that UMRWA is UN agency for human development works to provide support and protection to the Palestinian refugees registered with it in Jordan, Lebanon, Syria, the West Bank, and Gaza Strip, until a solution to be found for their plight, and UNRWA is funded almost entirely by voluntary contributions from the members of the UN.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 25\07\2016:

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon

- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- 8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza
- More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015
- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1134 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 11935 days, water was cut for 684 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 987 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1179 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 840 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
