### Recent Updates

The Regular Army and some Palestinian groups loyal to it still continue to prevent the residents of Al Husseneia Camp in Damascus city from returning back to their homes for the 348 days respectively, since the Regular Army is completely controlling the camp.

It is mentioned that the residents have escaped of their camps due to the heavy clashes that broke out about two years ago between the Regular Army alongside with Palestinian groups loyal to it with groups affiliated to the Free Army.

In Damascus city, the water cut continues in the Yarmouk camp for 47 days respectively in light of the deterioration of health crises and the fears of diseases and epidemics related to the lack of hygiene due to the scarcity of water. Meanwhile, the checkpoints of the Regular army and groups of PFGC still impose strict siege to the residents for 477 days respectively.

Returning to Damascus city, sporadic shelling targeted the surrounding towns to Khan Dannoun camp with a number of shells which was heard clearly inside the camp. In terms of living aspect, the residents of the camp are suffering from the high cost of living and widespread of unemployment, while the camp receives hundreds of Palestinian families who were displaced from the camps because of the shelling, clashes, and siege.

In related context, warplanes hovered above Khan AL Sheih camp coincided with the sound of powerful explosions as a result of the bombing of surrounding areas and farms. Meanwhile, all roads that link between the camp and the surrounding areas are still closed except for "Zakih- Khan Al Sheih road."

On the other hand, a number of Palestinian and Syrian refugees, who their boat was launched last week from Mersin city in Turkey, launched a call for the Danish authorities to intervene to not to get them down at Malta, where they were rescued by Danish ship, but through their way, there was a boat for the Maltese Coast Guard, who in turn demanded to deliver the Palestinian and Syrian refugees to be transferred to Malta.

#### Civil Work Committees

Palestinians of Syria Committee in Sidon city in Lebanon in cooperation with Al Islah Charity Association have participated on Saturday 52-10-2014 to distribute 100 food baskets to some Palestinian families who were displaced from Syria to Sidon city southern Lebanon.

### The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics:

- The Yarmouk Camp: The Continuance of the siege by the Regular Army and PFGC for the 477 respectively in addition to the power cut for more than 560 days and the water cut for 47 days respectively. The number of the siege victims is 155 victims.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the 379 days respectively.
- Al Sheina Camp: The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the 348 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp:-The residents left the camp since 548 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled the camp.
- Dara'a Camp: Almost 194 days without water and a complete absence of basic services.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: the roads that linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for the Zakia road.
- Khan Danoun Camp: economic crises continue, specially the unemployment and the high prices.
- Al Nairab Camp: the power is still cut for more than a year.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: relative calm situation in light of the economic crises.
