Recent Updates

Palestinian Ambassador in Serbia, "Mohammed Nabhan" denied, through his Facebook account, all accusations contained in the report published by a Serbian newspaper about his involvement selling visas to Palestinians to smuggle to Europe.

The ambassador confirmed uncertainty of news published by the Serbian newspaper which he described as "the yellow and scandals newspaper", adding that "the ownership of the newspaper belongs to ringer axel Springer Company based in Zurich at Switzerland and known as a Media and public relations within the Zionist lobby in Europe," he said.



It is noteworthy that a Serbian newspaper published a report about accusations addressed to "Mohammed Nabhan", the Palestinian Ambassador in Serbia that he sells visas for immigrants to enter Serbia then to Europe in exchange for 5,000 Euros per visa, exploiting the good relationship between Serbia and the Palestinian Authority.

The report included information that the Ambassador sold 125 visas during the first half of this year, and that the amount that has been levied is estimated with 800,000euros, while the newspaper pointed out that investigations are underway to determine the merits of this crime.

The newspaper added that the ambassador deals with only VIP customers, which kept his secret unrevealed till the newspaper uncovered it, as well as the partner in this crime is "Mousa Al Bawab," owner of a butcher shop, which was denied by Ambassador altogether, accusing the Zionist lobby in Europe responsible for the publication of such news.

On the other hand, Syrian warplanes targeted farms surrounding Khan Al Shieh camp with two raids near Al Salam highway, which closed the road because of shelling and intensification of clashes between the Syrian army and armed opposition groups, coincided with artillery shelling in the vicinity of the camp, while the artillery shell fell on Al Rida Street.

The Syrian army continues to close all roads leading to Khan Al Shieh camp, except "Zakya— Khan Al Shieh." which is the only outlet left for the people of the camp to reach the capital, Damascus.

Meanwhile, human rights activists transferred information by released detainees who witnessed a number of Palestinian refugees in the prisons of the Syrian regime. In the military security branch in Daraa, on 11.21.2015, the refugees Ubada Al Kanani and his brother Mefleh were last seen; they are from Daraa Camp, as well as Kheir Allah Al Saleh also from Daraa camp.

Documentation Center of Detainees and Missing Palestinians in Syria also transferred information by a released detainee on June 2015, who was detained at Fayhaa branch of Political Security in Damascus, reported the names of some detainees; they are: Yousef Darbi and Ibrahim Darbi from Al Aedein camp in Hama were transferred from Fayhaa branch to Sednaya prison, the refugee Mahmoud Miari from Al Aedein camp in Hama, who became sick and was transferred from Fayhaa branch to an unknown destination, the refugee Abdel-Rahman Al Jalaf who was transferred from the branch to an unknown destination, and the refugee Zaher Mwafaq Mubashir.

The AGPS documented the names of 1011 Palestinian prisoners, who are still unaccounted for.

On the other hand, Palestinian camps and compounds in Syria suffer from the migration of Palestinian families and youth to Turkey and European countries, as a result of the security and living conditions.

The AGPS correspondents reported that many refugees are heading daily to Turkey to try to gain access to the European asylum countries despite the tightening of the Syrian authorities to refugees travel to Turkey, while

a lot of young people and families in Turkey are waiting legal or illegal ways to reach the European mainland.

This is due to the prosecution of the Syrian security services and their groups to Palestinian youth to force them joining the Palestinian Liberation Army, as well as the security tightening on the youth movement in and outside the camps, and the arrest of the security services for many of them.

In terms of living aspect, despite several camps and Palestinian compounds are under the regime's control, residents are still suffering increasingly, as they suffer of high cost of food prices and widespread unemployment among young Palestinians, which led to the weakness of financial resources that would force young people to go out in search of their livelihood and their academic and professional future.

The continuation of war events and targeting their compounds with missiles, in addition to the sensitive location of some camps such as Nairab, which made it a strategic point for the Syrian opposition groups, and its ongoing attempts to impose siege and control, made the residents and youth in a constant state of worry for their lives, as well as the participation of many youth in fight against the Armed opposition groups alongside the Syrian army.

More than 100,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are outside the Syrian territories while thousands of them waiting for a chance to get out of Syria, as a result of the continuation of war and the targeting of their camps.

Turning to Greece, Palestinian activists confirmed to the AGPS that about 350 Palestinian and Syrian refugees being held in the Greek military island of "Faramicos", and there are dozens of children and women among those detained for at least three days without food or Health Care.

The Greek islands make up the main road to refugees fleeing from the war in Syria toward Europe from the Turkish coast.



In Lebanon, dozens of Palestinian Syrians displaced in Lebanon participated in the Palestinian Evening hosted by each of Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon and Dar Al Awda for Studies and Publishing, under the title "For you Jerusalem".



The evening was implemented at the Municipality of Sidon Theater southern Lebanon on Wednesday, in solidarity with the people of Jerusalem and to condemn the attacks against Al-Aqsa Mosque.

It is worth mentioning that more than 45,000 Palestinians Syrian displaced from Syria to Lebanon in order to escape the consequences of war in Syria, but they suffer from very bad living and legal situation especially with regard to residencies and work.

Numbers and Statistics till 25/11/2015

- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 877 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 947 days, water was cut for 437 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 184 victims.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 738 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 939 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 583 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
