Victims

The Palestinian refugee woman, "Maysar Abed Bishtawi," 65 years, from Yarmouk died after diabetes on board a death boat which was launched from Egypt towards Italy, where her body remained on the boat until a Dutch vessel rescued the boat.

Meanwhile, the Palestinian refugee "Ali Qwaider" Abu Hussein, from Daraa camp died following the shelling of Muzareeb compound South of Syria.

Recent Updates

Daraa camp and Al Muzareeb compound for Palestinian refugees southern of Syria witnessed most violent clashes since months , where the Opposition brigades launched a violent attack on the Regular Army forces in the southern area, coincided with targeting the camp , Al Muzareeb compound and the surrounding areas with shells and explosive



barrels by the warplanes, which resulted in some victims and Mr. Ali Qwider was recognized amongst victims and some injured people and Mr. Yamin Yasin Awwad was recognized amongst the injured in addition to a mass destruction to properties.

The residents live in fear and worry due to the high pace of military work amid fears from the Regular Army to repeat its raids.

It is referred that the Opposition declared earlier the beginning of it battle "the South Storm" against the Regular Army in the southern area in order to control Daraa city.

In a different context, the Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus witnessed violent clashes yesterday between the Regular Army alongside the PFGC Against Al Nusra Front and ISIS, coincided with bombing which targeted the Yarmouk street and caused a fire in one house of the camp's houses.

The Regular Army and PFGC are still imposing a strict siege on the Yarmouk camp for 728 days respectively.

In Damascus Suburb, the so called Popular Committees which are affiliated to the Syrian Security at Sahnaya arrested Hekamt Seyah after she was heading to ask them about her brother Jihad Seyah who was arrested by those committees, it is mentioned that Jihad Seyah is a member of the PLA.

In Lebanon, a state of anger prevailed amongst the displaced Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon in general and at Ein Al Helwa camp south of Lebanon in particular due to the continuation of arresting the Palestinians of Syria refugees in charges of expired residencies and the continuation of the arrest campaign which is carried out by the Lebanese authorities against the refugees whose their residencies were expired and threatening them to leave. It is noted that the Lebanese General Security seizes the passport and the ID of everyone who wants to renew his residency and they postpone granting them the residencies.

Some activists warned the Palestinians of Syria refugees whose residencies expired specially at Ein AL Helwa not to get out and enter of



the camp through the Lebanese Army checkpoints, where the Hesba checkpoint which is located in AL Tahtani Street at Ein Al Helwa, Al Hokomy and Al Tameer arrest a number of Palestinians of Syria refugees including women and men in charges of expired residencies.

On the other hand, the Palestinians of Syria committee in cooperation with the Humanitarian Relief Association distributed a number of food parcels to the Palestinians of Syria families at Hosh Al Harema town and Ghazza at Al Beqa' Al Gharbi area.

The committee of the Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon in cooperation with Al Taqwa Charitable Organization distributed 363 food parcels to the displaced Palestinians of Syria families at Nahr Al Bared camp at Tripoli in northern of Lebanon.

It is referred that the number of the Palestinians of Syria refugees in Lebanon is 51000 refugees distributed on all areas and Palestinian camps and their legal situation is the most prominent problem that they live in addition to their prevention to work.



In Turkey, the Committee of the Palestinians of Syria in Turkey distributed financial aid on about 17 Palestinian Syrian families in the Asian division at Istanbul and witnessed the situation and described it as difficult.

The Committee also distributed some food parcels that were presented by the Humanitarian Brotherhood Association to the Palestinians of Syria at Al Raihana city. The committee is supposed to continue distributing the food parcels in Karahan , Has and Al Eslaheyya and the committee documented that 65 Palestinians of Syria families at AL Raihana city in Turkey.

Numbers and Statistics till 25/6/2015

- *80,000 Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.*
- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The number of Palestinian detainees who were documented by the AGPS has reached 899 detainees, and 398 victims were killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 728 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 798 days, water was cut for 288 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 176 victims.*



- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 609 days respectively.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 590 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 792 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 435 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
