Latest Developments

The National Coalition for Syrian Revolution and Opposition Forces unraveled a decision to transfer members of the White Helmets (Syria Civil Defense) from Yarmouk Camp to the nearby towns of Yalda, Babila, and Beit Sahem.

Those stranded in Yarmouk will reportedly be affected by the move in an area where the White Helmets represent the sole relief body which provides services to the wounded civilians, extinguishes wildfires, removes rubble, and secures water.

Several relief institutions and charities have gone out of operation in Yarmouk following ISIS execution threats.

Meanwhile, 80% of
AlSbeina buildings have
been subjected to quasitotal destruction,
particularly in the area
stretching from Muadh
Ibn Jabal Mosque to the



Kurds Oven, which makes the western entrance to the shelter.

Residents of AlSebeina Camp for Palestinian refugees in Rif Dimashq have been denied access to their homes via government-run checkpoints since November 7, 2013.

Bloody hostilities between the government troops and the opposition battalions in and around AlSbeina forced dozens of families to seek shelter elsewhere. The clashes culminated in a tighter cordon by the regime squads on all corners of the shelter.



In the meantime, Palestinian refugees from Syria in Lebanon have slammed the apathy maintained by relief institutions and charities vis-à-vis the tragic situation they have been made to endure in the Lebanese territories.

At the same time, the Lebanese authorities continue to rebuff appeals for renewing the residence permits of the Palestinians of Syria, blacklisting them as illegal immigrants and tourists. Palestinians from Syria are also denied the right to work in the Lebanese territories.

Palestinians of Syria: July 25, 2017 Statistics:

- •At least 3,540 Palestinians, including 463 women, were killed in wartorn Syria.
- •1,621 Palestinian refugees, including 102 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.

- •Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine - General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,461 days in a row.
- •196 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.
- •Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,199 and 1,048 days.
- •Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,542 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 295 days.
- •Nearly 85,000 Palestinian refugees from Syria fled to Europe until the end of 2016.
- •31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.
- •17,000 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.
- •6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.
- •8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.
- •1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.
