"The Regular Army Targets a Mosque at Khan Al shieh Camp, and Continues to Target the Only Road Left for Civilians"

#### **Victims**

Palestinian and Iraqi media resources reported that the Palestinian Syrian refugee, Khalid Ibrahim Hussein Awwad, known as Abu Al Nar, died in the Iraqi Capital Baghdad by a sectarian armed group.

He was killed while reviewing the municipal council in the municipal circle area east of Baghdad, at the call of intelligence Service, where witnesses said he was kidnapped by gunmen in a car license Interior Ministry plate in front of the police and security forces.



his body was found on Wednesday 25/5/2016 morning in the forensic medicine (the morgue) after he was abducted for more than 10 days, where the forensic medicine department connected his family to inform them that they have the body of their father at the Department and asked them to come and receive it.

Awwad is a resident at the municipalities' compound for the Palestinian refugees, and he was arrested several times; he was born in 1968 at Deraa-Muzareeb, and he is the acting of Alguds mosque. He came from

Syria to Iraq in the beginning of the eightieth and married to a Palestinian Iraqi woman, and he has one son.

It is worth mentioning that the Palestinian refugees in Iraq suffer if assassination and murder campaigns by the sectarian armed groups, while more than 80% of them were forced to migrate outside Iraq.

### **Recent Updates**

The AGPS correspondent in Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus western suburb reported that the Syrian regular army targeted Al Huda mosque directly with a shell and resulted in only material damage. The mosque is a place of worship only and does not contain militants or weapons such as the



entire camp, according to one of the refugees in the camp, while one of the worshipers said if the shell coincided with gathering of worshipers there would be a number of causalities.

Meanwhile, bombing targeted the main Street and East regions of Khan Al Shieh camp, which caused panic among the residents, especially children for fear of being part of the tragedy, while the Syrian regime forces stationed in the regiment 137 continues to close the road between Khan Al Shieh and Zakia, as a result of being targeted by artillery and tank shells

This road is considered the only artery that supplies the camp essential needs, knowing that all roads leading to the camp are closed, forcing residents to go through Zakya in spite of high seriousness, as it always exposed to shelling by the Syrian army, and many residents died during their passage, as the people called it the road of death.



It should be noted that the AGPS has documented the names of 14 victims from Khan Al Shieh camp died as a result of being targeted on the road of Zakya-Khan Al Shieh.

In the south of the capital Damascus, violent clashes broke out in the Yarmouk refugee camp south of the Syrian capital Damascus the day before yesterday between Nusra and ISIS. The clashes erupted while ISIS attempt to control the Ja'una street in the camp, resulting in injuries between the two parties, while Nusra repelled an attack by ISIS in order to break into the place, where they used light and medium machine guns, Molotov cocktails, and plant more explosive devices in the houses of civilians.

The AGPS correspondent confirmed that ISIS seized Al Basil hospital in the Yarmouk camp and transfer all its contents to Al Hajar Al Aswad

area, as they spread ads in places of their control to let the smoking ban in the streets, as they distributed leaflets urging women to wear the Islamic hijab in the streets of the camp.

Clashes among ISIS and Nusra broke out at the beginning of April 2016 after ISIS tried to impose full control over the areas controlled by Nusra, which facilitated the entry of ISIS into the camp in the beginning of April 2015, while ISIS imposed control over large parts of the camp.



#### Lebanon

Al Mazar UNRWA School honored the Palestinian Syrian student, Sarah Muhannad Mansour, a displaced refugee from Syria in Al Bidawi camp-Tripoli-south Lebanon, after she obtained the first place in the experimental exams of ninth-grade.

It is noteworthy that the number of Palestinians of Syria students in the Bidawi camp up to about 550 students, while the number of Palestinian Syrian families is 850 families out of about 12,000 Palestinian Syrian families fled to Lebanon to escape the war in Syria.

#### **Italy**

Seven immigrants drowned off the Libyan coast following the sinking of a boat carrying them in the Mediterranean because of the extra payload, and in turn, the Italian Coastguard said they managed to rescue 500 refugees had drowned after they left Libya towards the Italian coasts in order to emigrate to European countries in search for safety and security and a decent life.

The United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) quoted for immigrants have been rescued from drowning off the coast of Libya that they had seen nearly 500 refugees died at sea because of the sinking of their boat, according to the Commission 41 people from African, Syrian, and Palestinian nationalities were rescued, including three women and a 3-year-child were transferred to Kalamata in Greece.

- 8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza
- More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015
- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1076 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1137 days, water was cut for 626 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 930 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1 121 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 783 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
