### Latest Developments

The joy of Eid for tens of thousands of Palestinian refugees from Syria, scattered across over 20 countries, has been marred by the rampant warfare. Dislodgement, deportation, and visa restrictions have added insult to the injury.

Thousands of Palestinians fleeing war-ravaged Syria have sought shelter in Lebanon, Jordan, Egypt, Turkey, Libya, Sudan, Thailand, Malaysia, Sweden, Denmark, Germany, Britain, the Netherlands, Finland, France, Switzerland, Brazil, Chile, and Canada, among other destinations.

According to UNRWA estimates, over 120,000 Palestinian refugees fled war-torn Syria.



The situation has gone for worse due to the visa-restrictions and entrybans slapped by Syria's neighbors and several European states.

Meanwhile, Palestinian refugees from Syria sheltered on Greek islands have sounded distress signals over the exacerbated humanitarian conditions they have been subjected to.

Palestinian refugees in Greek have been enduring medical neglect and poor hygiene, along with the lack of relief assistance and the propagation of poisonous reptiles in the makeshift tents they have been locked up in.

Some 400 Palestinian refugees, mostly from the Syrian camps of Daraa, Yarmouk, AlAydeen, and AlHusseiniya, have been stranded in makeshift tents and under-equipped halls on such Greek islands as Lesbos, Chios, Leros, and Kos.



#### Civil Action Committees

The Palestine Charity Commission, in partnership with Shourouq AlShams Foundation, distributed Eid clothes to 50 children sheltered in and near AlMuzeireeb. Every child also received a sum of \$15.

The move makes part of the "Joy of Eid Campaign" launched by Shourouq AlShams and the Palestine Charity.

#### Palestinians of Syria: June 26, 2017 Statistics:

- At least 3,521 Palestinians, including 463 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.
- 1,612 Palestinian refugees, including 100 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.
- Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,433 days in a row.
- 196 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.
- Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,169 and 1,020 days.
- Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,513 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 247 days.
- Nearly 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until the end of 2016.
- 31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.

- 17,000 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.
- 6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.
- 8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.
- 1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.
