Recent Updates

The Palestinian refugee Sajeda Abu Daraji from Der'aa camp died since three days due to a wound she attained while trying to reach Turkey with her children after they were exposed to an ambush by the Syrian Regime on Al Badeya road southern Syria.



The AGPS correspondent insured that the refugee's children were injured and they are in the regime's hospital now, he also referred that the family of Sajed are from Der'aa camp that left to Al Mzareeb inside Der'aa governorate after the frequent bombing before they decided to leave to Turkey, AGPS was not able to confirm the news from another source.

It is referred that Al Badeya road through Allejah is the only road for the southern Syria residents far from the control of the Syrian Regime, through this road hundreds of refugees entered Turkey from this road because all the roads whether closed or cut by the Regime's checkpoints, where many Palestinian refugees were arrested including women on these checkpoints.

In a related context, the Syrian Army targeted Al Muzareeb town with artillery bombing using mortar shells, which resulted in destruction in the



civilians' houses and spread a panic and worry states amongst the Palestinian refugees in the Town, no news about casualties.

The number of the Palestinian refugees in Al Muzareeb is about 8500 Palestinian refugees and they live in tension and fear due to the continued bombing that the town and the surrounding areas bombing with explosive barrels and mortar shells, which resulted in a number of victims and wounded in addition to a huge destruction of houses and properties. AGPS documented 31 victims from the Palestinian refugee from the residents of Al Muzareeb Compound since the beginning of the war in Syria.

Media outlets in Khan Danoun camp mentioned that the young youth Yousif Halawa was injured and he is a member of the PLA in the ongoing clashes Adra, he is from the residents of Khan Danoun. The PLA major general Tareq Khadra insured that the PLA fights besides the Syrian Army from the beginning of the conflict in Syria. Tareq continued that the PLA fights in more than 15 locations in Der'aa Suburb, Al Swedya, Damascus, Al Zabadani, Adra, Maleha, Jober, Madameyya, Dareya and Tal Kurdi. It is referred that the Palestinian refugees in Syria are obliged to join the military service in the PLA, each one who doesn't join the army will be exposed to chasing and detention, where many PLA members deserted from the Army and joined the Opposition to fight the Syrian Regime.

In Britain, MAP, Medical Aid for Palestinians, which is a humanitarian British organization, launched an electronic campaign to sign a petition to put pressure on the British government to work to improve the situation of the displaced Palestinians of Syria. The petition contains



demands such as adding the Palestinians of Syria within the protection program and the various humanitarian programs whether those Britain sponsor or share responsibility with the International community specially the Syrian crisis.

The petition demands the British Government to provide UNRWA with more sponsorship and encourage the rest of donor countries to increase their contribution so that UNRWA can overcome the financial crisis and achieve the minimum response needed for the Palestinians of Syria.

The AGPS correspondent in London referred that petition will be delivered to each of Robert Goodwill , Minister of State for Immigration at the Home Office, and Rory Stewart, Minister of State at the Department for International Development, in September 2016 during an international conference that will be held in USA about the Syrian issue.

MAP stands for Medical Aid for Palestinians, it is a humanitarian organization located in London, UK. MAP works in the health sector for



Palestinians and it has offices in the West Bank and Lebanon. It is considered one of the donor partners for UNRWA. It has noticeable activities in Britain like practicing advocacy and lobbying on the British Politicians, Parliamentarians, and the decision makers about putting policies that serves the Palestinians from a humanitarian prospective.

Al Wafa European Campaign continues its relief projects that target the displaced Palestinian Syrian families in Lebanon, where it distributed the day before some aids in Ein Al Helwa camp in Sidon. They distributed financial and relief aid, according to one of the relief workers. The campaign relief workers insured that most of the families suffer from the cruel living situation and they are in a serious need for the basic living needs. It is referred that the number of the Palestinians of Syria families who live in Ein Al Helwa is 870 families out of 12000 families escaped to Lebanon from the ongoing war in Syria.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 26\08\2016

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*
- *42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon*
- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey*
- *1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza*
- *More than 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid -2016*



- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1166 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1226 days, water was cut for 714 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 18٧.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 1018 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1209 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 869 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
