"Vacuum Missiles Target khan Al Sheih Camp in the Western
Damascus countryside"

Victims

"Foua'd Ali Mansour", (35) years old, Palestinian refugee from Yarmouk was killed because of torturing in the Syrian regime's prisons after a year of arrest. His family said that he was arrested in August 2015 while he was travelling to Hasaka city.

It's worth noting that AGPS had documented in a previous time the death of (452) Palestinian victims who were killed because of torturing in the Syrian regime's prisons.



Children, women and even elderly were among the victims.

"Abd Al Salam Ali Al Abeid" Palestinian refugee from Al Hujaira area in Damascus countryside and a ranked member of the Palestinian liberation army.

He was killed during the unstoppable confrontations between the Syrian regime forces on the one hand and the armed opposition groups on the other hand in Deir ez-Zor city in the east of Syria. The number of Palestinian liberation army victims' has reached (187) according to the Group's statistics, (21) of them were killed in September 2016.

It's important to mention that General "Tarek Al Khadra'" the Chief of Staff of the Palestinian liberation army confirmed that the liberation army is fighting alongside the Syrian army since the beginning of war in syria. It's fighting in more than 15 sites in Daraa country sides, Al-Suwayda and Damascus. Including Al-Zabadani, Adra, Al Malihah,

Joubar, Moadamieh, Darya and Tal-Kurdi. Considering that Palestinian refugees in Syria are obliged the military service for the Palestinian liberation army and whoever disobeys its orders will be arrested. Many of its soldiers had defected to it joining the opposition groups fighting the Syrian regime.

Recent Updates

Khan Al-Sheih camp in the western Damascus countryside was under missile attack in yesterday's early morning. AGPS's reporter stated that the Russian and Syrian helicopters bombed civilian houses in the camp with three vacuum missiles. It targeted the high street and AL Huda mosque surroundings leaving massive destruction of houses and properties. No injuries were reported.



Helicopters has dropped more than 20 explosive barrels around Al-Sheih camp in the western Damascus countryside. It targeted in Al Abassa area and Alderkhbayh town which led to the death of five civilians including the medic.

It's worth mentioning that Khan Al-Sheih camp and its outskirt are witnessing a remarkable escalation in hostilities, bombings using explosive barrels, mortars and artillery. It led to a huge number of casualties among civilians, who are suffering from severe living conditions due to the closure of all roads leading to the camp, people have to take Zakia Road in spite of its highly danger since the Syrian regime sites were always being targeted there.

In the besieged Yarmouk camp in the south of Damascus ISIS has released on Saturday 24 September the Palestinian refugee "Mohannad Farhoud- Abo Abd Alelah" after 7 days of arrest on charges of dealing with pro-Syrian opposition groups.

Al Farhoud, who was well-known for his support of ISIS, is the former official for local council in Al Yarmouk, which is controlled by the Syrian opposition. Then he established a relief board called it "Al Yarmouk Relief Board".

Palestinian -Syrians who managed to reach German are complaining from the lateness of delivering their residence permits. Sometimes, they take more than a year which reflects poorly on the refugees who are waiting the reunion of their families, who were displaced between Syria, Lebanon and Turkey.

In addition to the economical burdens that a refugee has to afford in those countries specially securing living expenses for their families who are waiting their reunion. Reunion's paperwork may need several months before it becomes ready.

A wide range of Palestinian refugees are suffering from the ramifications of leaving their footprints in Italy and other countries which abide them to leave their footprints during their journey towards north Europe. When their asylum permits' are rejected then the refugees should appoint a lawyer to follow the case and usually it takes a year or two then in order to grant their residence permits later. On the other hand, some of of the German states ignored Italy's footprints.

There weren't any official statistics about the numbers of Palestinian Syrian refugees in Germany, who classified as stateless persons according to German laws. luckily, Germany has to commit Geneva's treatment, which recommends to facilitate the nationalization of the stateless persons according to the German law of the year 2000.

Civil Work Committees

Jafraa Institution for Relief and Development, in the south of Damascus, keeps serving the displaced families from Yarmouk to the neighboring towns like (Yalda, Beit sahem and Babila). They were enforced to leave their places after ISIS's control over the camp since the beginning of April 2015. Jafraa's voluntary team was cleaning and spraying pesticides in the streets and some lanes that contains more than 2000 families. It's good to notice that Palestinian refugees in Yarmouk and its outskirt are suffering from severe living conditions because of the continual siege by the regime's army and PFGC groups for more than (1196) days.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 26/9/2016

- (15500) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan.
- (42,500) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon.
- (6000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015.
- (8000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey.
- (1000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza.
- More than (79,000) Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid-2016.
- Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for (1196) consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than (1257) days. water was cut for (747) days respectively. The number of siege victims is (187).
- Sabina Camp: Regular Army is still forbidding the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for (1049) days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about (1241) days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.

- Daraa Camp: It is now almost (899) days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were totally destroyed.
- Jermana, AL Sayeda -ZeinabAl Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hama: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road
