"Greek Coast Guards Found Two Corpses of Palestinian Syrian Refugees near the Turkish Borders"



- The Action Group: 188 victims from Daraa camp were killed since the beginning of events in Syria.
- Kidney diseases and inflammation of intestine are spread in the Yarmouk camp.
- Transportation crisis is still continuing in Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus suburb.
- A video shows a checkpoint that besieged the Yarmouk camp while it raises Hizbollah Lebanese Flag.
- The residents of Alhusseinia camp are still homeless for 411 days.
- Completion of the rehabilitation project of metal roofs for Palestinians of Syria homes in the camps of Sour city.

Victims

The Greek coast guards found two corpse of "Mohammed Faris Owais", was born on 1993, and his mother, who lives at the Yarmouk camp, near Alexander city at the Turkish borders.

Statistics

The documentation and monitoring team of the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria revealed that the number of victims from Daraa camp south of Syria, since the beginning of the events in Syria, has reached 188 victims, including 107 were killed during the bombing, as 25 were killed by sniper shot, 3 were killed due to torture, 19 refugees were field executed, 7 were killed in unknown circumstances, 2 refugees were killed in a car bomb, one refugee was killed due to the lack of medical care, one refugee was burn, and a refugee from Daraa camp was killed by a white weapon.

Recent Updates

The besieged residents of the Yarmouk camp are suffering increasingly with the entrance of winter, which forces them to use primitive ways for cooking and heating. The firewood became their only source in addition to some ways they innovated to get some fuel out of the Plastic, while this way only provide very small quantities of fuel cannot be used to operate the small capacity engines.

In terms of medical aspect, the temporary General Manager of PRC "Jamal Hammad" confirms that the Yarmouk camp is facing health, medical, and humanitarian difficult conditions that cannot be described. Kidney diseases are wide spread due to the infected water, inflammation of intestine, severe shortage of protein for children and elder people, as well as jaundice and dehydration for children, typhoid, Maltese, scabies and lice, especially in the ranks of schools that are a far cry from the general standards for school grades.

On the other hand, activists traded on the social networking sites video titled "Lebanese Hezbollah flag at the entrance of the besieged Yarmouk refugee camp south of Damascus ..." where the video shows a checkpoint of the regular army and groups of PFGC raising the Lebanese Hezbollah flag, which the activists considered it an evidence of the party's participation in the siege of their camp.



It is noteworthy that those checkpoints imposed siege on the people of the Yarmouk refugee camp for about "509" days, as the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria could not made sure of the video from another source.

Meanwhile, Khan Al Sheih camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus suburb is suffering of the continued closure of all roads between it and the neighboring areas because of the shelling and repeated clashes taking place in towns and farms surrounding it, which forced people to take the road of "Zakia - Khan Al Shieh" Despite the risk of sniping and bombing, it is referred that during the past few months, many buses were targeted in this road.

In the meantime, despite the clearance of Husseneia camp in Damascus suburb of any armed groups of the Syrian opposition, and despite the complete control of the regular army since "411" days, however, some Palestinian groups loyal to it prevented the camp residents from returning to their homes since that time, where clashes that broke out

between the regular army and groups belonging to the Syrian armed opposition, forced them to leave their homes and flee into the neighboring towns and refugee camps and compounding which increased their economic burden.

It is noteworthy that the people of the camp has launched dozens of calls that appealed to the Syrian officials, the regular army and Palestinian factions loyal to it to allow them to return to their homes, but despite repeated promises, they were not allowed to return to their homes until today.

Release

The Syrian security released Maisoun Hadid from Al Aedein camp Homs on 25/11 after being detained for more than two months, as it mentioned that she works in Bisan hospital, she is in her forties and originally from Safad city in Palestine.

The two young men, "Faiz Mohammed Moussa" in his thirties, originally from Safad city in Palestine, and the young man, "Maher Mahmoud Hussein" in his thirties, were also released on 18/11/2014, after two days of arresting them from their place of work.

While the young man, "Ayman Al Talib" was released on 11.19.2014, two days after being arrested, he is in this fifties, originally from Safad city in Palestine, it is noteworthy that all the released are from Al Aedein in Homs.

Arrest

"Ahmed Hammoud" from Al Aedein camp in Homs was arrested by Al Shmas police members on 11.25.2014, noted that he is a government employee in Al Iskan Military Foundation, he is in his sixties, and originally from Tarsheiha village in Palestine.

Lebanon

Palestinians of Syrian workers gathering in Lebanon in cooperation with the Palestinians of Syria Committee announced the completion of the rehabilitation project of metal roofs in Sour area camps, as the project included Qasimiyah, Wasta, Barghaleya, Al Burj Al Shamali and Al Rashedeia areas.

It should be noted that the project, which lasted seven consecutive days, was an attempt to alleviate the suffering of Palestinian refugees in the winter and about 60 Palestinian Syrian families has benefited from it.

In a related context, Civil Committees at Sour area southern of Lebanon distributed food rations to the children of Palestine Syrian refugees under the age of five.



The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics till 25S/11/2014

- The number of Palestinian refugee victims in Syria has reached 2556.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 509 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 592 days, water was cut for 79 days

respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 157 victims.

- 41 Palestinian refugees were killed outside of Syria.
- 96 PLA members were killed due to Clashes in Syria.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 411 days respectively.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 381 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 581 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 226 days without water and a complete absence of basic services.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.
- Khan Danoun Camp: Economic crisis is still continuing, specially unemployment and high prices.
- Al Nairab Camp: Power is still cut for more than a year.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Ca mps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quite situation in light of the economic crises.
