***“A Bomb Exploded in front of the Headquarter of Al Nosra Front in the Yarmouk Camp, Italian Navy Rescues a Boat Carrying a Number of Palestinian Syrian Refugees”***

### **Victims**

*The young man “Iyad Hanienu” from Al Nairab camp was killed due to torture in the Syrian regime prisons after being arrested for about a year.*

### **Recent Updates**

*An explosive bomb was exploded yesterday in the Yarmouk camp in front of the headquarters of Al Nosra front opposite to Palestine hospital which resulted in material damages. According to the Action Group correspondent” this explosion came in light of the raise of assassinations and political arrests Pace in the Yarmouk camp lately, which affected many Palestinians, the last one was the member of Yarmouk gathering “Bahaa Saqer” and the two young men Ahmed Al Sahly and Abdullah Bader”, by unknown group. Meanwhile, the food distribution to the Yarmouk camp is still suspended because of snipping and clashes in the area of distributing food parcels at the entrance of the camp lately.*

*On the other hand, people of Al Nairab camp in Aleppo suffer of suffocated living and economic crises because of the continuation of the ongoing conflict in Syria and their suffering was increased by the lack of water and the continuation of Drinking water cut for about a year and a half. The water crises forced the residents, after losing hope of water return, to dig wells and extend hose networks to the narrow lanes and sell water at a price of 200 SL(1.5\$) for the 1000 liter tanker.*

*AL Nairab camp is still out of power for several months till this moment which forces its residents to share private generators to connect the electricity to their houses and streets.*

*Moreover, the heavy clashes pace is still continuous between the Syrian opposition and the Regular Army in the vicinity of Handarat camp and the central prison in Aleppo, coincided with explosive barrels that targeted the camp once in a while. The residents of the camp are complaining of the impact of suffering due to the displacement from their camps to the neighboring areas in Aleppo.*

*In the same context, a state of quiet and careful prevailed Khan Al Shieh camp coincided with heavy explosion sounds that rocked the camp as a result of the bombing of its vicinity. In terms of living aspect, the residents suffer of severe shortages in food, fuel and medicine.*

## **UNRWA**

*The UNRWA declared the names of Al Nairab and Handarat camp residents who did not benefit from the financial aids of 10000 SL.*





### **Civil Work Committees**

*The Civil Defense team of Palestine Charity Committee stopped the fire that broke out in a house in the eighth of March neighborhood in front of Palestine hospital in the Yarmouk camp due to the bombing that targeted the camp, as the fire resulted in material damages.*

### **Jordan**

*The Jordanian authorities prevented the UNRWA representative of entering Cyber City compound to communicate with the Palestinian refugees and to check their situation and humanitarian state. It is worth mentioning that the Palestinian refugees, in side Cyber City in Jordan, launched calls and appeals to the human rights organizations, PLO, Palestinian factions and UNRWA to help them and to solve their problem.*

*The refugees of Cyber City feel that they are isolated of the outside world and have been treated like prisoners in a camp, more like a closed security prison, where they are detained and not allowed to go out only within constraints and bails.*

*The Palestinians of Syria refugees inside this compound complain of conditions they described as inhuman that forced many of them to escape and became wanted to the Jordanian security forces. It is worth mentioning that Cyber City compound is a building of 6 floors contains 140 rooms, located in Al Ramtha town ( about 100km north Amman) near*



*the Syrian borders. This compound was originally a residence for Asian workers who worked in factories at the industrial town in Irbid.*

*It is referred that the Palestinian Syrian refugees who were displaced from Syria to Jordan has reached about 10687 refugees, according to the UNRWA statistics and they have been distributed to: Irbid, Zarqa, Amman, Al Mafraq, Al Zaatary camp and Cyber City. Those refugees have formed about 2391 families 48% of them are under the age of 18, 52% of them are females, 30% of them are the only source of support for their families, and the family rate is about 4.1 persons. About 196 of them are in Cyber City, while the data referred that 56% of the Palestinian refugees who came from Syria to Jordan are holding Jordanian travel papers, 22% of them are holding Palestinian travel papers and 21% are holding Syrian travel papers.*

### ***Italy***

*The Italian navy and coastguards have managed, yesterday on 26th of August 2014, to rescue a boat that was carrying a number of Palestinian Syrian and Syrian refugees as they arrived to the Italian regional water. It is worth mentioning that the boat was launched from Subrata town in Libya and was carrying a number of Palestinians of Syrian who escaped of the hell of the ongoing conflict in Syria to Libya asking for safety and secure.*

*After the refugees became hopeless about finding safe and good life they decided to immigrate to Europe countries searching for a decent life. The*



*Italian coast guards announced the rescue of 4000 illegal immigrants during the past three days and recovered at least 19 bodies since the end of this week.*

*On the other hand, the Italian Interior Minister Angelino Alviano said that he had asked the European Union to help his country in order to ease the financial pressure as the fight against illegal immigration, requiring financial support of 10 million Euros.*

### **Libya**

*Libyan coastguard arrested a number of Palestinian Syrian and Syrian families while they were trying to leave Libya across the sea from the area of Zuwarah , they were heading to Italy asking for safety, security, and dignified life.*

*It is noteworthy that the security tensions in major cities in Libya cast a shadow over the Palestinian Syrian refugees, forcing them to gamble their lives and the lives of their families and escape to Europe riding "boats of death ".*
