#### Recent Updates

The AGPS Documentation and monitoring team documented the names of 51 Palestinian detainees from Al Aedein camp in Hama who are still unaccounted for. The camp's residents, who receive a large number of displaced families from various camps and cities of Damascus, Aleppo, Idlib, Hama, Deirez-Zor, Raqqa, Daraa, and Latakia, are suffering from a strict security cordon imposed by the regular army at the entrances and exits of the camp. In addition, they also suffer from raids and arrests carried out by the regular army between now and then. It is noteworthy that the toll of Palestinian detainees in Syrian prisons amounted to 976 detainees.



Sporadic artillery shelling targeted Khan Al Shieh camp comes from the Syrian army site in Talet Al Kabouseia, where several shells landed in the vicinity of Sharaf and Al Saed Streets, causing no injuries.

It is worth mentioning that Talet Al Kabouseia site has become a disturbing obsession for the people of Khan Al Shieh camp because of the harm that they have suffered from that area which has been targeted with

shelling by tanks and heavy artillery, which led to many victims and wounded among residents of the camp.



Meanwhile, they complain about the continuing shelling and sniping that target Zakia - Khan Al Shieh which impacted negatively on their living status, as well as numerous crises, including the acute shortage of medical and food and high prices, as a result of the continuous closure of the only way that links them with the Syrian capital Damascus.

In turn, Palestine Charity Committee ended the project of "For all people," while 2700 sacrifices meat were distributed to all residents and displaced people at Khan Al Shieh camp.

In the meantime, a number of mortar shells targeted different places of the Yarmouk camp yesterday, where the shelling targeted Al Rija square and Loubeia Street without casualties among civilians.

Al Quds charity Organization distributed 240 shares of sacrifices meat to displaced Palestinian families and most needy in Al Zahira area adjacent to the Yarmouk camp, including "orphans - special needs - and families numbering more than six members."

In central of Syria, World Relief Organization in cooperation with the Charity Committee implemented an entertainment activity for the children of Al Aedein camp in Homs, in order to draw a smile on their faces in light of the war events in Syria.

The activity included some meaningful songs and distribution of gifts for all children involved.

However, the residents are still suffering of a large tightening by Syrian security forces, where there are 180detainees are still unaccounted for, according to the AGPS statistics.

The camp, which is controlled by the regular army, is under unprecedented and intense security tightening, so that its residents now feel that they are in a big prison, where on June 21, 2015, the Syrian authorities built an iron fence that separates the neighborhoods of Al Aedein camp in Homs and the surrounding neighborhoods, without any service corridors between the two sides, which doubled their economic suffering and reflected negatively on their living conditions.

#### Lebanon

No signs of Eid among the Palestinian refugees coming from Syria to Lebanon. Suffering, grief, and pain continuously they live because of abandoning their homes and the loss of their property, while they suffer from very difficult situations on all life, economic, and social levels.

Being treated as tourists by the Lebanese government has increased and aggravated their tragedy, which fall their due rights of the Lebanese state, as well as they do not feel safe and secure as a result of volatile policies practiced by the public security against them. In addition, not to renew their residency permits and the campaign of arrests carried out from time to time under the pretext of the end of their residency, while the Lebanese government does not allow the displaced Palestinian refugees to work on its territory.

In terms of living aspect, the recent decision of UNRWA to reduce its services and cut shelter allowance has impacted negatively on their living and humanitarian conditions.

In a different context, The Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon in cooperation with Al Taqwa Committee distributed about 550 sacrifices meat shares to the Palestinians of Syria families at Nahr Al Bared camp in Tripoli north of Lebanon.

In the occasion of Eid Al Adha Al Mubarak, a delegation from the Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon and the Women Affairs department of the Committee organized a visit to elder people and patients of Palestinians of Syria at Ein AL Helwa camp in Sidon south of

Lebanon in order to strengthen the social relationships amongst them and to see their living situation.



#### Numbers and Statistics till 26/9/2015

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 816 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 886 days, water was cut for 376 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 678 days respectively.

- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 879 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 524 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
