"After 23 Months, the Tragedy of the Two Palestinian Syrian Refugees Detained in the Egyptian Prisons Ends"

#### **Recent Updates**

The Egyptian authorities released the two Palestinian Syrian refugees, Fadi Shareef Hawarna, 47 years, and Alaa Abdulwahab Durgham, 24 years, after being detained for 23 consecutive months in charges of illegal migration, while all other countries refused to receive them.

The families of the two refugees confirmed to the AGPS that they obtained entry visas to Sudan after great efforts, and they entered Sudan about 20 days ago with no problems.



The two refugees were transferred among the Egyptian prisons. After they entered Egypt under official visa on Thursday 10-7-2016, they tried to travel illegally by "Death Boats," trying to reach Europe, yet they failed. The Egyptian coast guards arrested them with a group of travelers, while a deportation order was issued to be deported from Egypt within 15 days.

For being Palestinian Syrians, all countries refused to grant them entry visa, so they remained at "Shubrakheit" prison hoping that the UNHCR would intervene to solve their problem. After 40 days, all prisoners were released except for them, and then they lost hope.


On 14-2-2015, the two refugees were transferred to a prison in Ismailia city. After the failure of deporting them to the Gaza strip, they were deported to Alqanater prison in Cairo on 24-8-2015, and then they were placed in a deportation prison to the Gaza Strip. It is referred that AGPS launched a number of calls through media calling the international, humanitarian and rights organizations to release them.

News from Yarmouk reported that a number of Opposition groups' members sneaked from Yelda area to Yarmouk and clashed with ISIS in Al Magharba neighborhood and Palestine athletic city in Yarmouk which led to the control of the brigades over lots of points in the camp.

Eyewitnesses insured that the control over those points didn't last long in Al Magharba area and Palestine Athletic city in Yarmouk camp, where the Opposition groups withdrawn after ISIS sieged the area and ISIS completely controlled Al Ja'ouna neighborhood after Al Nusra withdrawal from the area to Al Rija square.

A number of Yarmouk residents were questioning about the way that Al Nusra left their camp; some said that it was coordinated amongst the conflict parties and some said they left the camp through the sewage networks.

Abnaa Al Yarmouk Movement "Al Buraq Brigades" declared through its Facebook page that the Yarmouk Freedom Battle has started against ISIS, where it refers that the battle started on all confrontation lines and insured that violent clashes broke out on Sunday night on confrontations

lines of Al Masbah, Al Tadamoun and Al Magharba Street. They insured that they were able to defeat ISIS from all fighting lines.



The Regular Army and PFGC groups continue to impose siege over the Yarmouk camp for 1106 days respectively, power cut for 1167 days respectively and water cut for 656 days respectively.

In Ukraine, the child Saleh Salam, 16 years, from Yarmouk got the title of "Peace Ambassador Child" by the International Federal for Children because of his humanitarian activities in collecting donations for the displaced children.

Saleh was born and lived as a refugee at the Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus and fled to Lebanon after the war in Syria and then he stayed in Ukraine. The refugee life and the misery that he lived with thousands of refugees let him help the children and alleviate their suffering.

Regarding his clear social interests, his school honored him as an activist besides he was distinguished to get the Peace Ambassador Child title by the International Federal for Peace Children, where only 15 children got this title all over the world.

In France, the Palestinian Refugee Dalia Adnan Jaber, 16 years, was the first among her colleagues in the French DELF exam with total of 95%, where she presented her school among all schools of the area after she enrolled a year late. Dalia received her certificate from the Governor and the Academic Director of Tarn and the higher studies manager in the French DELF.

Dalia Adnan Jaber, who was born in Yarmouk southern of the Syrian capital, Damascus, her parents are Palestinians and her father is a professor in philosophy and a writer, her mother is a fashion designer. They migrated from Damascus to Turkey then they stayed in Bulgaria with her family till July 2015, where she was obliged to leave Bulgaria with her mother and her little brother on a French plan and settle down in Paris.

Dalia is just like thousands of Palestinian Syrian families who suffered from the war consequences in Syria and became scattered in the world. She suffered from the diaspora of her family between France and Bulgaria. She said that she wants her father, who is a doctor, a writer, and a translator, in Bulgaria to join her in France.

She added that she didn't see any of her family members 5 years ago, she lost many people, and farewell many friends with tears. She stressed that she wanted to see the positive side of everything. She continued that if

there is problem, only the coward who surrenders. Today, Dalia is fluent in many languages and she says that it's not good to be a refugee but it is a good chance to learn many languages.

#### Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 27\06\2016:

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon
- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- 8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza
- More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015
- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1105 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1167 days, water was cut for 656 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 959 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1 151 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 812 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
