“An Explosive Bomb Targets a Car at the Yarmouk Camp, Resulting in Four Victims and a Number of Injuries”



Injuries caused by the explosive in Yarmouk Camp

- A new victim due to torture raises the total toll to 270 victims
- A Palestinian Girl was killed in Aleppo due to the targeting of her school.
- Heavy clashes and security tension in the vicinity of Handarat Camp in Damascus city.
- Syrian security arrests an Officer of the Palestinian Authority at AL Aedein Camp in Homs.
- Consultative meeting at Ain AL Hilwa in Lebanon to discuss the conditions of the Palestinian refugees.

Victims

The young man Ali Darraj from the Yarmouk Camp was killed due to torture in the Syrian regime prisons after being arrested for more than a year. It is mentioned that the number of Palestinian refugees who were killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons amounted to 270 refugee since the beginning of the events in Syria till today, according to the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria statistics.

Recent Updates

An explosive bomb exploded yesterday evening at the Yarmouk Camp in Damascus, the bomb targeted the car of a leader in “Aknaf Bait AL Maqdis” brigades, and resulted in four victims included a child and another leader his name is “ AL Hout” and the other victims still unknown.

The explosion that broke out at al Orouba neighborhood near “ Hamza Abdul Mutaleb” Mosque also resulted in a number of injuries, and it is mentioned that this was not the first accident of targeting members of armed brigades with explosive barrels. In another hand the Regular Army and groups of PFGC still imposes their strict siege of the Yarmouk Camp since 479 days.

The heavy clashes are continue between the Regular Army and the Free Army in Handarat Camp in Aleppo, and resulted in dozens of injuries from the both armies. It is mentioned that Handarat Camp is controlled by Syrian Opposition for 550 days.

In the same context, the child “ Jna Imad Farouk Mousa” 7 years old form Al Nairab Camp and was displaced with her family to AL Hamdaneia area, as she was killed due to the shells that were dropped at the area while she was at school.

In Homs, the Security Detachment that responsible of Al Aedein Camp arrested an Officer of the Palestinian Authority “Nizar Mohammed Salim Omar”, 50 years, from AL Shajara village in Palestine, after raiding his house in the camp.

“Omar” was arrested twice while he was coming back from Iraq on 2003 and was detained in the Syrian prisons for a year and a half, the second time was at the Yarmouk Camp in a demonstration in front of “AL Waseim” Mosque and was arrested for a year and three months, then he was released due to his deteriorated health condition in the beginning of 2014.

A number of institutions and civil work committees held, yesterday at Ain AL Hilwa Camp southern Lebanon, a consultative meeting included Islamic institution in Sidon camps, Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon, and Displaced Palestinians Follow-up Committee.

Institutions and bodies operating in the Yarmouk refugee camp continues to "Imatat Al Aza" campaign, which aims to clean up the streets of the camp and the removal of waste and carried it over in order not to spread of epidemics and diseases among the residents of the camp.

On the other hand, the Palestinians of Syria Commission in Lebanon distributed 100 school bags with full stationery to the Palestinian Syrian students in Nahr al-Bared camp and to the children associate to Jenin boys club, this contribute on the distribution comes in a bid committee to help the displaced Palestinian people and alleviate the economic burdens.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics

- ***The Yarmouk Camp:*** - *The Continuance of the siege which is imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC for 479 days respectively in addition to the power cut for more than 562 days and the water cut for 49 days respectively. The number of the siege victims is 155 victims.*
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:*** - *The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 381 days respectively.*



- ***Al Sbeina Camp:*** - *The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 350 days respectively.*
- ***Handarat Camp:***-*The residents left the camp since 550 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled the camp.*
- ***Dara'a Camp:*** - *Almost 196 days without water and a complete absence of basic services.*
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:*** - *the roads that linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for the Zakia road.*
- ***Khan Danoun Camp:*** - *economic crisis is still continue, specially the unemployment and the high prices.*
- ***Al Nairab Camp:*** - *the power is still cut for more than a year.*
- ***Jermana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:*** - *relative calm situation in light of the economic crises.*
