“Homemade Missiles Target Al Neirab Camp in Aleppo”



Heavy shelling targeted Al Nairab camp

- Explosive barrels targeted the vicinity of Khan AL Shaih and Dara'a camps.
- Delay of the implementation of the Yarmouk camp neutralization agreement increases the residents' tension.
- Palestinians in Syria receive the Holy Month of Ramadan with economic and life stifling crises.

Recent Updates

Heavy shelling with homemade rockets and shells targeted Al Nairab camp in Aleppo, which led to a large destruction of a number of civilian homes and a number of vary severity injuries.

Reports indicate that the shelling comes from areas controlled by the opposition, while the camp, which is under the full control of the Syrian Army, suffered in the last few days of repeatedly bombings. Al Nairab camp considered to be a strategic point and a gateway to Aleppo international and military airports.

In the same context, explosive barrels targeted Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus city, which cause a state of tension amongst the residents.

Thus, electricity returns back to the houses of Khan Al Sheih people in the light of lack of health services and food supplies as a result of frequent interruptions to the streets that connect the camp with the city center.

People in the Yarmouk camp are still waiting for the implementation of the rest items of the neutralization agreement which was signed about nearly six days by the President of the Palestine Branch representative of the Syrian Authorities, and a number of representatives of civil and relief organizations and military brigades inside the camp.

A state of anxiety and resentment spread among people because of the delay of implementing the agreement and return to their homes, while the siege, imposed by the Regular Army and groups of the Popular Front - General Command on the Yarmouk camp, is still continuing since about a year.

Warplanes hovered above Dara'a camp southern Syria coincided with voices of violent explosions turned out to be caused by the bombing of areas adjacent to the camp with explosive barrels. Regarding the situation of living, people of the camp suffer from a severe shortage of health services in addition to the absence of the most basic services, in light of the great destruction that hit most of the homes due to repeated shelling, forcing most of the families to flee to the neighboring areas.

Palestinian refugees in Syria receives the Holy month of Ramadan in difficult conditions, where they suffer of power, communications and transportation outages in addition to the high cost of living and the lack of food supplies, high prices and widespread of unemployment. It is worth mentioning that most of the people of these camps are displaced from their camps where they are forced to rent high cost homes, which compels them additional economic burdens.



Civil Work Committees

Charity Commission for the Relief of Palestinian people in Aleppo distributed 1750 food baskets to families of Al Neirab camp for current June.

The Charity Commission continues provide drinking water to people of Yarmouk camp throughout water tanks, in an attempt to alleviate the effects of water cuts for long hours.
