Latest Developments

Special sources confirmed to AGPS that UNRWA-run Damascus Training Center (DTC), in AlMezzeh, is to be evacuated soon as shelter for the displaced Palestinian families.

According to our sources; DTC's head, Fawzi AlMadfa', gave a green light to the evacuation order, expected to be put into effect in August.

Families taking shelter in the center will be transferred to Rif Dimashq shelters, including Jaramana and Adra.

Nearly 2,000 people have been taking cover in DTC, fleeing such beleaguered Palestinian refugee camps as Yarmouk and AlSbeina.

Meanwhile, UNRWA and the General Commission for Palestinian Refugees announced Friday July 28 as the date scheduled for the departure of secondary school students from Yarmouk to Damascus to sit for catch-up round exams.

The registered students are slated to gather at AlJarmak Alternative School at 08:00 a.m. on Friday.

Students from southern Damascus are allowed access out of the area following the approval of the Syrian security forces.

In another development, three Palestinian students—Nizar Sa'id AlNader, Mahmoud Jamil Noufel, and Ahmed Mahmoud Ibrahim— sheltered in Khan Alsheih Camp, were released from Syrian penitentiaries.

The three students were kidnapped by the Syrian regime troops on June 4 on their way to Artouz to sit for secondary school exams.

At least 235 Palestinians from Khan AlSheih Camp, along with 1,621 refugees seeking shelter in war-tattered Syria, have been enduring mysterious fates in Syrian government lock-ups.

• *At least 3,541 Palestinians, including 463 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.*

- *1,621 Palestinian refugees, including 102 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.*
- *Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine - General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,463 days in a row.*
- *196 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.*
- *Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,201 and 1,050 days.*
- *Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,544 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 297 days.*
- *Nearly 85,000 Palestinian refugees from Syria fled to Europe until the end of 2016.*
- *31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.*
- *17,000 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.*
- *6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.*
- *8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.*
- *1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.*
