
Recent Updates

Extreme Dire living difficulties facing hundreds of Palestinian Syrian refugees who returned to the Gaza Strip to escape the war and arrests in Syria, where they are suffering from hard economic conditions, in addition to their inability to secure housing and employment, due to the catastrophic situation of the Gaza Strip, which is caused by the last Israeli, in addition to the ongoing siege for several years.

In this regard, one of the Palestinians of Syria described their situation there to the AGPS correspondent, saying "this Eid passes while we do not have any money for our children, we do not get so far only unimplemented promises, which consisted of salaries, between now and then".

The refugee, who preferred not to be named, said, "After the sit-in was carried out in 15-9, we were promised with salaries, but that has not been implemented so far".

The Palestinian Syrian families in the Gaza Strip had carried out a sit-in, in the middle of this month, in front of the Palestinian cabinet, protesting, as they described with, neglect and procrastination policy practiced by the government of national reconciliation towards them.

They demanded the government, the PLO, the Palestinian factions, and the international institutions to take its role in the protection of refugees who came from the Arab countries, to meet their basic humanitarian needs, and to work on providing them with financial dues assessed by the Council of Ministers on 04.06.2015.

It should be noted that the number of Palestinian Syrian families in Gaza has reached about 240 families.

On the other hand, heavy shelling with explosive barrels targeted the sides of Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb, where the surrounding farms near Al Saed Street was targeted with at least four explosive barrels, resulted in a state of panic among residents of the camp.

It is worth mentioning that the neighboring towns of the camp, especially near Kenitra province, are witnessing escalating violent clashes during the past few days, between the regular army and the Syrian armed opposition groups.



Turning to Turkey, where Turkish media sources reported that 17 refugees from Syria died on Sunday, after their boat sank off the coast of the province of "Mugla" of the Aegean Sea, south-west Turkey.



The sources pointed out that the boat capsized shortly after lift-off, adding that the Coast Guard managed to rescue 20 others. The agency

clarified that the refugees were on their way to Greece, in an attempt to enter illegally.

According to the Turkish agency of "Dogan," the victims are from Syria, including a woman and five children, and added that the border Turks guard recovered the bodies from the wooden boat, which left Turkish Bodrum towards the Greek Leros Island, while the migrants were unable to get out of the cockpit where the water surrounded them.


Civil Work Committees

Palestine Charity Committee in Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb finished the project of distributing sacrifices meats to hundreds of families and displaced families from the nearby camps and towns.

According to the Committee, (2700) shares of meat were distributed to the families there, at a time where most of residents suffered of unemployment, especially after the regular army checkpoints closed all roads linking between the camp and the center of the capital, Damascus.


In a related context, Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon in cooperation with Al-Quds Charity Committee distributed nearly 5 thousand shares of sacrifices meat during Eid al-Adha to the Syrian and Palestinian Syrian families displaced to Lebanon and residing inside Al Bidawi refugee camp in northern Lebanon. It is noteworthy that approximately (860) Palestinian families were displaced from Syria are living in the camp.



Numbers and Statistics till 27/9/2015

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 817 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 887 days, water was cut for 377 days

respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.

- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 679 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 880 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 525 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
