"1244 Victims from Al-Yamouk Camp Were Killed Since the Beginning of The War"

RECENT UPDATES

The monitoring and documentation team in the AGPS has revealed that the number of Palestinian Victims from Al-Yarmouk camp since the beginning of the war has reached 1244, as follows:

447 were killed due to shelling, 185 due to siege and medical care shortage, 195 due to gunshots, 151 by sniper shots, 163 were tortured to death, 16 executed in the field, 13 by car bomb, 14 assassinated, and 2 died in crowd jostling while trying to collect food aid parcels.



In western countryside of Damascus city, residents of Khan Eshieh Camp complain about the severe shortage of medical services, as all hospitals had been closed following the war acts affected the region, in addition to the significant drop of services in the UNRWA clinic which limited its services to the minimum.

This crisis comes in time the camp residents suffer from many other crises such as the relief work weakness and the roads' cut which affected the living conditions directly.



In Al-Yarmouk camp, the water cut continues since September 2014, residents had to collect drinking water from the surrounding areas, in other times, they had to pull water from artesian wells, which most likely to be contaminated with dust and sediments, this caused a notable increase of kidney diseases and general cleanness diseases inside the camp according to medical reports.

In Lebanon, the Charity Association for the Relief of the Palestinian People, distributed 325 schoolbooks to Palestinian students of Aafaq Educational Centre.

The educational center, located in Wadi Al-Zieneh town, was opened last year, as the Charity Association and the World Relief Association both contributed in it significantly. It aims to provide help and assistance to Palestinian families displaced from Syria to Lebanon, especially in the region of Kharroub.



Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics Until 28 March 2016

- *15,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan,*
- *6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*



- *More than 71,200 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe until the end of December 2015.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine – General Command), continued for 1017 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 1078 days, water cut for 566 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 186 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 873 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 1063 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: Running water cut continues for 727 days, and 70% of its buildings were destroyed.*
- *Jarmana, AL-Saieda Zainab, Al-Raml, Al-Aedein Homs and Al-AedeinHama: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al-Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia-Khan EShieh road.*
