#### **Recent Updates**

The AGPS correspondent reported that there is a number of Hendarat residents were injured following a mortar shell that targeted the Ninth Building Unit in the University City near opposite to the Faculty of Art; he also insured that there are children among the injuries.

The concerned social networks published the names of injures in Handarat camp. They are Fethiye Salama, sahir Derby, Ahmed Nabil Hamidi, Samira Khatib, Imran Abbas, Montaser Eltayeh, and Abdelkader Mogalad.



The camp's residents still in unfolding tragedy because of the displacement and expulsion for several months due to the conflict in Syria, which resulted in the migration of all residents. Some residents were distributed on campus of ninth unit in Aleppo, others left towarsd Al Neirab camp, while some others has resorted to Turkey.

In the meantime, still the Yarmouk Palestinian refugee camp in Damascus, witnessed a state of tension and lawlessness in the light of the continued clashes and cases of sniping and mutual between elements "Daash" on the one hand and elements of the "Front victory" on the other hand, on his part, a population the camp of the working group that sporadic clashes broke out between the two parties which used light and mortar weapons, noting that civilians from the camp's residents are

trapped homes because of the spread of snipers on rooftops and Guensm of streets and alleys, as they suffer from poor living conditions of very poor due to lack of food and medicine and water for them

Violent clashes broke out in the eastern Ghouta in Damascus suburb between the PLA members and ISIS at the sides of Tashreen thermal plants at Haran Al Awameed. The clashes resulted in a number of injuries and victims from both sides.

Tal Kurdi area in Damascus suburb, which is located between the two cities of Douma and Deraa, is considered one of the most prominent areas where PLA victims died, in addition to Tal Sawan area near Tal Kurdi and Al Swaidaa south of Syria. According to the AGPS documented statistics, the number of PLA victims has reached nearly 172 victims.

The AGPS documentation and monitoring team revealed that 12% of the Palestinian victims, who died since the beginning of events at Deraa camp, are minor children, equivalent to 40 children, in addition a proportion of 17% of women who also died, equivalent to 55 women for 274 men.

The AGPS confirmed that the number of documented victims at Deraa city has reached 331 Palestinian refugees died since the beginning of the Syrian crisis in March 2011. The victims were scattered at Deraa camps and towns; such as: Muzareeb, Deraa Al Balad, Al Shiekh Maskeen, Al Mansheia, Al NAema, Tafas, Etman, Kherbet Ghazala, Saida, Al Sahara neighborhood, NAwa, Al Mahata, Al Sad road, the Jordanian borders, Al Sanmeen, the Yarmouk neighborhood, Al Kashif neighborhood, Basra,

Qarfa, Thaknat Al Hboub, NAseib, Houran, Taseel, Al Sabeil neighborhood, and others.

The AGPS explained ways of death for the 331 victims as follows: 170 victims died due to shelling, 35 victims died due by a sniper shot, 67 died with a gunshot, 3 victims died due to torture at the opposition detention centers, 20 victims was executed in the field, 15 victims died due to torture in the Syrian regime prisons, 10 victims died for unknown reasons, 10 victims died in a car bomb, a victims died due to the lack of medical care, a victim was burnt, 2 victims died with a white weapon, a victims died after being kidnapped, and a refugee died by the Israeli gunshot.

The Palestinians of Syrian Committee in Lebanon, in cooperation with Al Taqwa Committee, distributed summer clothes, on Wednesday, 27 April at Al Taqwa mosque hall, to a number of Palestinian Syrian families who were displaced at Nahr Al Barid camp in Tripoli south of Lebanon. The committee aimed at alleviating the refugees' pain and economic suffering.

The committee carried out a number of visits to poor families who were displaced from the Palestinian camps in Syria to Nahr Al Barid camp. The committee provided them with financial aid varying as needed, as well as it provided some very poor families with diapers for elderly people.

The Number of Palestinian Syrian families displaced at Nahr Al BArid camp South of Lebanon has reached 350 families out of about 12,000 Palestinian Syrian families who have taken refuge in Lebanon to escape the ongoing war in Syria.

#### Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 28/04/2016:

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon
- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015
- 8000 Palestinians of Syria Refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinians of Syria Refugees are in Gaza Strip
- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1048 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1109 days, water was cut for 598 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 186.

- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 902 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1093 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 755 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
