Victims

The two Palestinian refugees, Naief Ibrahim Nemer, surnamed as "Abi Nahel," and Ghassan Abu Setta died due to the Russian warplanes shelling that targeted a house at the outskirts of the river in the western lane of Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb. The shelling resulted in a number of injuries.



Recent Updates

The Russian warplanes carried out violent raid that targeted the outskirts of the river in the western lane of Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb. The shelling resulted in the death of at least two refugees and a number of injuries among residents. Activists confirmed that warplanes used cluster bombs which resulted in at least one victim and a number of injuries.

This comes in light of the escalation of repeated bombing that targets the camp and its vicinity with all types of heavy weapons by air and artillery bombardments. The surrounding farms and towns are targeted almost daily with explosive barrels and artillery shells.

On the other hand, a number of mortar shells targeted Al Wafedein camp which is inhabited with a number of Palestinian families. The shelling resulted in only material damages. The deteriorated security situation at towns and areas adjacent to Al Wafedein camp, which is located 20 km away from the capital Damascus, in addition to the frequent shelling that targets the camp impacted negatively on the residents who are originally suffer of poverty, high rates of unemployment, and poor living conditions even before the Syrian war.

A number of Palestinian families and young people who have migrated to Europe returned back recently to Nairab camp in Aleppo, where the AGPS monitored the return of a number of Palestinian Syrian families and young people to Neirab for various reasons.

After they left Syria to escape the war and risked themselves to gain access to Europe they were shocked by obstacles were not taken into account. They mainly suffered of the procedural side, especially with regard to transactions of asylum and family reunion. Refuge procedures may take more than a year and a half in some countries like Sweden and some other Scandinavian countries.

In addition, they suffer of housing problems, adapt, and learning the language, while minors who have reached (18 years, who are waiting for their residency, were deprived of their right to reunification with families, prompting many of them to return to Syria, despite the risks they may face.

It is noteworthy that multiple sources confirmed to the AGPS that some of the "Palestinian authorities" loyal to the Syrian regime exploited a number of Palestinian Syrian youths in Europe in order to fight among the ranks of the committees and groups in Syria in exchange for the settlement of their security situation and to help them return to Syria.

Many Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon and Egypt confirmed that the Turkish Embassy in Lebanon continues to stop issuing visas for Palestinian Syrian refugees without giving reasons, despite the achievement of most of the requests to the conditions required by the embassy.

Activists believe that the Turkish authorities exercise undeclared prevention to the entry of the Palestinians of Syria Turkey for more than two years where all embassies refuse visas without giving reasons.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 28\06\2016:

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon
- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- 8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza
- More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015
- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1106 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1168 days, water was cut for 657 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 960 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1 152 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 813 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
