Recent Updates

Mortar shells targeted Al Hajar Al Aswad area nearby the Yarmouk camp in Damascus, and resulted in the death of two girls "Hala Mohammed Kheir Ibrahem" and "Ward Al Sham Matar".

Meanwhile, the strict siege imposed by the regular army and groups of the PFGC is still continuing for more than a year and a half, while their checkpoints prevent the entry of fuel, medical supplies, and flour for more than a year and a half, as the residents are suffering of severe shortage of food and medical supplies which led to the death of 157 victims.

It is noted that some relief organizations were allowed to enter limited quantities of food aids to be distributed to the residents once in a while, as happened yesterday, when UNRWA entered and distributed some food rations, while the water is still cut for 81 days respectively which is exacerbates the tragedy of the besieged residents.

In another hand, heavy explosion sound were heard at the vicinity of Al Aedein camp in Hama, causing a state of horror amongst the residents, while news reported that the AGPS could not make sure of that the explosion resulted in the targeting of Hama Military Airport. The residents of the camp are suffering of several economic crises, most important is the unemployment and the high cost of living, noted that Al Aedein camp is considered one of the relatively quiet camps.

In Damascus Suburb, a group of the Syrian Opposition in Khan Al Sheih camp kidnapped Mohammed Nayef Salah, one of UNRWA employees who work as a school guard inside the camp, two days ago. According to our correspondent inside the camp, the family of Mohammed Salah closed the main street in the camp protesting on kidnapping their son which resulted in some problems amongst the residents and it was developed to clashes.

It is mentioned that the Syrian Opposition Groups committed several abuses towards the residents such as shooting them, as happened on 9\7\2014, which led to two victims Mohammed Methqal Al Qadeya and Mohammed Saleh Saleh and a number of wounded, only Essam Hussine and Ali Hamada were known amongst the wounded.

In Egypt, despite the transfer of the charge, which the Egyptian administrative prosecution accused the Palestinians of Syria Refugees, from illegal immigration to war refugees, 56 Palestinian refugees are still detained by the Egyptian authorities. It is referred that the Egyptian authorities detained the 56 refugees while they were trying to reach the Italian coasts through the Turkish coasts on 25th of October where they were victims of a scam by smugglers who left them on one of the islands in front of the Egyptian coasts that the Egyptian authorities detained them from. It is mentioned that the Egyptian security released all the Syrian detainees and kept 56 Palestinian refugees because of the refusal of the surrounding countries to receive them and the refugees were given the choice to be deported to Syria or to stay in detention.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics till 28/11/2014

- The number of Palestinian refugee victims in Syria has reached 2560.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 511 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 594 days, water was cut for 81 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 157 victims.
- 41 Palestinian refugees were killed outside of Syria.
- 96 PLA members were killed due to Clashes in Syria.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 413 days respectively.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 383 days respectively.
- *Handarat Camp*: Residents have left the camp for **583** days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 228 days without water and a complete absence of basic services.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.
- Khan Danoun Camp: Economic crisis is still continuing, specially unemployment and high prices.
- Al Nairab Camp: Power is still cut for more than a year.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Ca mps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quite situation in light of the economic crises.
