"196 Palestinians Died Due to Blockade, Medical Neglect since Outburst of Syria Warfare"

Recent Updates

Palestinian refugee Mahmoud Mohamed Youssef Abu Ria, a resident of AlSayeda Zeinab Camp for Palestinian refugees in Rif Dimashq, died as he took part in the



unabated hostilities rocking the Syrian territories.

According to AGPS data, 873 Palestinian refugees were fatally gunned down in war-ravaged Syria.



Meanwhile, AGPS documented the death of 196 Palestinian refugees, mostly in Yarmouk Camp, in Damascus, as a result of medical neglect and undernourishment inflicted by the tough blockade.

A tough cordon has been imposed on Yarmouk Camp since mid-2013 by the government forces and their war abettors. Water and power supplies to the camp have also been chronically cut off. Civilians have been further prevented from leaving the camp to fetch much-needed foodstuff and medicines.

In the meantime, violent clashes flared up on Sunday between ISIS and Tahrir AlSham battalion (formerly known as AlNusra Front) in AlThalatheen Street, in



Yarmouk. Light and medium weapons and artilleries were used in the clashes. No injuries were, however, reported on either side.

At the same time, ISIS ruled that civilians' access out of and into AlRija area be allowed only from 10:00 a.m. to 05:00 p.m. and that no more than one kilogram and half of food items and two bread loafs be entered by every single resident.



In another development,
AlWafa Charity Cookery has
started a campaign to provide
Palestinian refugees from
Syria in the Lebanese Bekaa
Valley and in Yarmouk Camp,

among other areas south of Damascus, with Iftar meals (evening meal when Muslims end their daily Ramadan fast at sunset).

AlWafa Cookery staff members distributed on Saturday Iftar meals to 30 Palestinian families displaced from Syria in Bekaa and 150 meals to

Palestinian families deported from Yarmouk to Yalda, Babila, and Beit Sahem, south of Damascus.

According to one of the campaigners, the move makes part of underway attempts to alleviate the crisis endured by the displaced and stranded Palestinian communities in war-ragged Syria and Lebanon.

Along the same line, the Assembly of Palestinian Workers from Syria reached a medical cooperation agreement with Dr. Luay Mohamed, a pediatrician and general practitioner in Ein AlHilweh Camp, south of Lebanon.



The agreement, signed by Dr. Mohamed and the assembly's chairman in Lebanon, Mohamed Sweid, provides a 50% discount of the overall treatment fees for social card holders who are members of the assembly.

Dr. Mohamed expressed his heartfelt pleasure and optimism over the move, pledging to try every possible effort to tone down the agonies endured by the displaced Palestinian community and to combine forces with the assembly to that very end.

•At least 3,502 Palestinians, including 462 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.

- •1,603 Palestinian refugees, including 99 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.
- •Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,409 days in a row.
- •196 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.
- •Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,140 and 991 days.
- •Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,484 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 218 days.
- •Nearly 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until the end of 2016.
- •31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.
- •17,000 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.
- •6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.
- •8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.
- •1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.
