***“Rainwater Floods the Palestinians of Syria Refugees Tents in Kilis Shelter Center in Turkey... A Group of the Free Army Burns Official Documents for the Electricity Company in the Yarmouk Camp”***



**Kilis Shelter Center in Turkey**

- Clashes broke out in the Yarmouk Camp.
- The dignitaries and residents of "Hitteen" compound in Barzeh, Damascus demand to return back to their homes.

### **Turkey, Kilis**

*The rainwater, which was dropped yesterday night at Turkey, had drawn the tents of the Palestinians of Syria refugees in the Kilis Center Shelter. The rainwater forced the 300 of the refugees to leave their tents and they went to sleep in the Public Commission Center for the Palestinian Syrian Refugees in Syria.*

*Our correspondent clarified that the rainwater drawn the tents and what inside the tents which is dangerous on the health of children due to the cold. He added that the raindrops were accompanied with the power cut in the center which increased the difficulty of evacuating the tents.*

*The action Group correspondent continued that the Shelter refugees called the commission to take precaution procedures to face the winter season and what will be resulted, in light of the bad weather conditions in Turkey. They also demanded to secure safe heating installations for the refugees to protect them from the winter diseases and the burn accidents which could happen in the winter.*

*It is referred that dozens of the Palestinian camp residents left to Turkey since the beginning of the events in Latheikia and Al Raml camp in August 2011, according the UNRWA statistics the number of the Palestinian Refugees who are coming from Syria is 1500 refugees.*

### **Recent Updates**

*The suffering of the Yarmouk camp residents increased in the light of the water cut all over the camp for 20 days respectively, which forced the residents to wait for long hours to secure drinking water for their children. The camp witnessed the drop of a number of shells on separate places at midnight , coincided with clashes that broke out inside the camp between the Regular Army with the PFGC and the militants groups on the crossing of the Palestine street in the Yarmouk Camp.*

*In the same context, the Siege, which is imposed on the Yarmouk camp by the Regular Army and the PFGC, inters its 436 days respectively which led to 156 victims due to the shortage of medical care, food, food supplies and fuel. In a related context our correspondent inside the camp said that*

#### ***The water cut in Yarmouk camp***

*Jermana camp, which is 8km far from the Syrian Capital Damascus and located on the road that leads to the Damascus International Airport, is suffering from the shortage of basic services, food supplies, medicine, food and fuel in addition to the stop of the residents to work specially the freelancers which form a big number due to the ongoing conflict in Syria.*

*On the other hand, the dignitaries of the Hitteen Compound in Damascus called to return back to their houses and making the compound a safe place for them especially that the camp is still under the control of the Regular Army forces and the security committees loyal to it from Al Bayader and Oush Al Werwar due to its geographical location, which is in the middle of clashes area, in the public road beside the services compound, that is considered the basement for the Army and the Air force leadership in northern of Damascus, in addition to that it is closed to Al Bayader neighborhood which support the Syrian Regime.*

*It is also adjacent to the streets of Barzat Al Balad which was under the control of the Free Army. All these causes prompted the Regular Army to push its residents away and making it as a military area for the Regular Army, which led to damage a big part of the residents houses due to the clashes and bombing and most houses were stolen.*





### ***Civil Work Committees***

*The Jafra Organization services team continues to clean the streets and erasing the rebels from the Yarmouk camp in order to maintain the camp cleaned and to stop the spread of diseases. Jafra is also trying to secure drinking water for the residents where the camp suffers of a complete power cut and the prevention of fuel entry for operating the water pumps generators.*



### ***Cleaning and erasing the rebels from Yarmouk camp streets***

*The Popular Committee for Civilian Protection in the Yarmouk camp warned, in a statement it issued, the trees cut in the public gardens, facilities and the streets of the Yarmouk camp from everyone without any exception, it also stressed on that it will punish anyone who cuts the trees.*

*The Charity Commission for the Relief of the Palestinian People distributed 180 mattresses, from the Arab Syrian Red Crescent in coordination with the social affairs ministry, on the families in of the temporary center shelter that is called Taher Al Jazaeri. It is mentioned that the Charity Commission provide several health and relief services to the Palestinian people in all of Syria.*
