Victims

Palestinian refugee Hamza Fadi AlShehabi, from the Palestinian Popular Struggle Front died as he fought alongside the Syrian government troops in blockaded Yarmouk Camp.

Al-Shehabi's death brings the number of Palestinian refugees killed in the Syrian conflict to 3,485.




Latest Developments

Reporting from southern Damascus, AGPS reporter said ISIS militias deployed in Yarmouk Camp attacked at daybreak on Saturday areas led by Aknaf Beit AlMaqdis battalion.

Clashes burst out at the crossroads to Palestine Street and the roundabouts of the Palestine hospital and the cultural center.

Sources from Aknaf Beit AlMaqdis south of Damascus said ISIS fighters were left wounded in the raging clashes. Sounds of sporadic blasts have also been reported.

AGPS field reporter said ISIS deployment in the camp has been back to normal after a state of alert declared by the militia came to an abrupt end, following a round of fresh clashes with Fatah AlSham.



Over the past couple of days, ISIS stepped up military operations in an attempt to grab hold of Fatah AlSham-led area.

Civilians trapped in conflict zones and flashpoints have, meanwhile, sounded distress signals over the abject humanitarian situation wrought by the unabated hostilities and the tough cordon enforced by ISIS.

On Friday, Yarmouk Camp was struck with mortar shells. AGPS reporter could not identify the targeted locations due to the bloody confrontations between ISIS and Tahrir AlSham.

In another development, the Palestine Charity Commission, distributed children's milk to a number of Palestinian families displaced from Yarmouk to Yalda, Babila, and Beit Sahem.

According to the charity, civilians have been enduring an acute dearth in children's milk and much-needed foodstuff.

Hundreds of Palestinian families sheltered in Yarmouk have been forced out of the camp since ISIS held sway over the area in early April 2015.



Palestinians of Syria: April 29, 2017 Statistics:

- At least 3,483 Palestinians, including 455 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.
- 1,187 Palestinian refugees, including 87 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.
- Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,381 days in a row.
- 195 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.
- Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,112 and 963 days.

- Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,456 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 190 days.
- Nearly 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until mid 2016.
- 31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.
- 17,000 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.
- 6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.
- 8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.
- 1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.
