"Aerial Raids Kill 6 Palestinians, and the AGPS Issues a Press Statement Condemning the Shelling of Khan Al Shieh Camp"

The AGPS issued a press release condemning the heavy and direct shelling that targeted Khan Al Shieh camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus suburb several days ago. It is believed that the shelling was by Russian and Syrian warplanes, causing massive destruction of lives and public and private properties. The AGPS warned that this shelling foreshadowing a complete plan of destructing the camp. The scenario of destructing Khan Al Shieh camp is similarly as to Yarmouk, Handarat, and Sbeina Camps in order to displace the residents.

The AGPS also denounced the serious violations and the targeting of civilians among the Palestinian refugees and called for respect and implementation of international conventions and treaties governing the protection of civilians in time of armed disputes.

The AGPS also demanded the Syrian Government to stop the ongoing targeting of civilians among the Palestinian refugees and those who are displaced from their camps inside Khan Al Shieh camp.

In addition, the AGPS called to end the siege imposed on the camp, to open the road, and to urgently allow the entry of medical staff in order to rescue the injuries and to pull victims from under the rubbles, in addition to provide aid and medical and emergency services needed.

The AGPS called the international community to bear its assigned role of maintaining international peace and security, and to put pressure on the conflict parties in Syria to neutralize the Palestinian camps and to provide protection for Palestinian refugees inside the camps as refugee camps recognized by UNRWA.

The AGPS called the Palestinian Authority, the PLO, and the national and Islamic factions to stand up to their historic responsibilities in defending the Palestinian people in the Diaspora, and to preserve the camps in respect of its symbolic among the refugees.

Recent Updates

The AGPS correspondent reported the death of 6 Palestinian refugees, including a child and a woman; they are:

Ali Hasan Mousa, the two brothers, Amer Fayez Nemer and Nour Fayez NEmer, the 5-year-child Suhaib Ezz Eldein Yousef, and Fatheya Tawfeiq NAhar. The refugee, Ezz Eldein Ali, a well-known field leader in Damascus suburb and a military leader of the Islamic Union of Ajnad AL Sham in Khan Al Shieh camp died. The Islamic Union of Ajnad Al Sham, which is one of the armed opposition factions in the western Ghouta, mourned Ezz Eldein "Abu Al Nour," in a statement declaring that he was a military leader in the western Ghouta in Damascus suburb.

Our correspondent reported that Russian warplanes targeted civilians' houses with destructive rockets, which has more destructive powers than explosive barrels. The shelling resulted in massive destruction of houses, in addition to many victims.

Palestinian activists confirmed that the Russian raids that targeted Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb serve the Israeli occupation directly, since the camp has no military value for each of the armed opposition or the Syrian Regular Army. The camp is completely free of militants and forms a safe haven for the displaced people, which insure that these raids are only serving the Israeli occupation who seeks to destroy the camps and make it empty with all means of shelling and siege.

Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb is one of the nearest Palestinian camps to the occupied Palestine, as it is located only about 60 km away from the Palestinian borders.

In the meantime, the AGPS correspondent in Homs reported that the Syrian security forces arrested six Palestinian refugees from Al Aedein camp in Homs in the recent period, confirming that the Syrian regime members raided the home of Adel Kayed on June 3, and arrested the young man, "Ibrahim Adel Kayed." He is an employee of UNRWA, in his thirties, originally from Al Sefsaf village in Palestine.

Syrian security forces also arrested the young man (Emad Ahmed Shaheen) on 06.04.2016, a resident of Homs camp. He is in his sixties, originally from Zeeb village in Palestine.

In June 20, members of "Hawash" checkpoint of the Regular Army arrested the refugee "Mahmoud Khaled Mahmoud Shatara," while he

was going to work from the camp to the villages, "Chen Brchin" west of Homs. He is in his twenties and originally from Tarshiha village in Palestine.

Members of Al Hamra checkpoint of the regular army also arrested the 16-year-refugee, "Khaled Mahmoud Mohammed Idris," originally from Ein Alzaytoun village in Palestine.

In the meantime, for the second time, Syrian security forces arrested the young man "Mohamed Moussa Shatara" Abu Musa on 21/6 in front of his home in the eastern neighborhood of the camp, "Ikrima neighborhood." He is in his forties and originally from Tarshiha village in Palestine.

In 22 June, the refugee "Moataz Abbas' (Abu Ezz), displaced from the Yarmouk refugee camp, was also arrested. He is in his forties and originally from Al Shajara village in Palestine.

Meanwhile, Nusra released the Palestinian refugee, Mohammed Mawed, after being detained for more than 5 months. Nusra and ISIS have arrested many residents of Yarmouk without any charges except for not obeying their orders and instructions.

In Lebanon, Al Islah Society implemented Iftar on Monday 27-6 for a number of Palestinian Syrian families at Dawoud Alali mosque in Wadi Alzina area- Kharoub-south Lebanon.

The number of Palestinian Syrian families who are displaced at Wadi Alzina area south of Lebanon has reached about 450 families out of 12,000 Palestinian Syrian families who resorted to Lebanon to escape the ongoing war in Syria.



Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 29\06\2016:

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon
- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- 8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza
- More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015

- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1107 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1169 days, water was cut for 658 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 961 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1 153 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 814 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
