"A Child Died and a Number of Women Injured due to Air Strike that Targeted Khan Al Shieh Camp"

#### **Victims**

The 16-year- Palestinian child, Mohammed Imad Raheel, died due to shelling that targeted Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb.

Meanwhile, the Palestinian refugee, Ibrahem Hameed Mahmoud, a PLA officer, died during the ongoing clashes between the Regular Army, the PLA, and the pro-regime groups on the one hand, and the Syrian armed opposition groups on the other hand in Adra town-Tal Sewan in Damascus suburb.

The PLA groups are fighting alongside the Syrian regime forces in more than a front, where the Palestinian youth in Syria, who are above 18 years, are forced to perform the PLA obligatory military services, unless he is wanted for the Syrian security. Hundreds of Palestinian youth were forced to migrate from Syria after they refused to fight alongside the Syrian regime.

The Palestinian refugee, Adnan Madi Alkhateib, a fighter of the armed

opposition from Nairab camp, died during the ongoing clashes between the Syrian regime and the pro-regime groups in Damascus suburb. The number of deaths, who died by gunshot among the Palestinian refugees since the beginning of events in Syria, has reached 762 victims, according to the documented statistics of the AGPS.

#### **Recent Updates**

Russian warplanes targeted Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb yesterday dawn, and resulted in the death of the 16-year-child, Mohammed Imad Raheel, in addition to 3 injuries among women.



According to our correspondent, the shelling targeted a house in the middle of the camp near an UNRWA school, while a state of panic spread among residents.

Meanwhile, artillery stationed at Talat Alkabouseia targeted houses in the western lane with a number of shells and resulted in material damage.

This comes amid high pace of military actions that target the camp and its vicinity, while a number of raids targeted the camp in the last weeks and resulted in tens of victims and injuries.

On the other hand, the PLO introduced 1000 food baskets to Yalda town south of Damascus for the relief of the Yarmouk people.

The total number of food baskets that were introduced by the PLO has reached 5000 baskets, as well as almost 6000 bread packs during the last few days.

This comes amid the continuous siege imposed by the regular army and GC groups 1138 days respectively, power outages for more than (1199) days, and water for 688 days respectively, in addition to the prevent of entering food and medical supplies to the besieged people through the main gate of the camp.



In Greece, hundreds of Palestinian Syrian refugees stranded in Greece complain of very harsh living conditions after all roads between them and the European countries were closed in the face of refugees who risked their lives to get to Greece from the Turkish beaches.

After closing the borders leading to Europe, the refugees were forced to stay in temporary refugee camps in Greece under very dire living conditions, where most refugees suffer from lack of hygiene and basic

services wherever they are, as most houses are temporary shelters or tents, under large spread of insects and poisonous reptiles and snakes and scorpions.

It is noteworthy that the European Union had adopted a strict policy of the refugee issue, especially on the Greek border, in addition to the agreement with Turkey to tighten and control the border and prevent immigration boats towards Greece.



## Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 29\07\2016:

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon
- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- 8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza
- More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015

- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1138 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1199 days, water was cut for 688 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 991 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1 183 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 844 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
