### Latest Developments

Reporting from Khan AlSheih Camp for Palestinian refugees, in Rif Dimashq, AGPS news correspondent said the Palestinian young man Adel AlArjawi was kidnapped by the Syrian security forces from his home in the area on Saturday morning.



The Syrian government forces deployed at Sa'sa' Branch also forced shopkeepers in Khan AlSheih Camp to paint their padlocks with the colors of the Syrian regime's flag.

Khan AlSheih Camp has been partially blockaded by the Syrian government troops. A number of civilians have also been kidnapped from the area, in contravention of the reconciliation deal struck with the opposition outfits and which led to the retreat of nearly 2,500 civilians from the camp.

In another development, the Union of Relief and Development Associations in Lebanon, in partnership with Dar AlWafa Clinic, announced the launch of orthopedic surgeries for refugee children in Lebanon.

Patients are slated to show up at the clinic on Wednesday from 12:00 a.m. to 03:00 p.m.

Lebanese, Syrian, Palestinian, and Iraqi children aged 10 or below will undergo medical check-ups to spot the deformations and set the surgery dates.

Meanwhile, Palestinian refugee Ubaida Alyan, aged 24, has been enduring a mysterious fate in Syrian government lock-ups.

Alyan, affiliated with the Islamic Jihad Movement in Palestine, was kidnapped by the government troops stationed in AlZahira, in Damascus, on March 31, 2014.

AGPS kept record of the names of 1,621 Palestinians incarcerated in Syrian regime penitentiaries, where 465 refugees also died under torture.



### Palestinians of Syria: July 29, 2017 Statistics:

- At least 3,542 Palestinians, including 463 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.
- 1,621 Palestinian refugees, including 102 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.

- Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,464 days in a row.
- 196 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.
- Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,203 and 1,052 days.
- Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,546 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 299 days.
- Nearly 85,000 Palestinian refugees from Syria fled to Europe until the end of 2016.
- 31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.
- 17,000 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.
- 6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.
- 8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.
- 1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.
