Latest Developments

Palestinian refugees from Syria in Lebanon have slammed the UNRWA, the Palestinian Embassy, and the Palestine Liberation Organization (PLO) for their reluctance as regards the tragic situation endured by hundreds of displaced families in Lebanon-based refugee camps.

The refugees spoke out against UNRWA cuts of its relief services and cash assistance previously allotted to war-affected families.



Speaking with AGPS on condition of anonymity, a Palestinian refugee lashed out at the Palestinian Embassy in Lebanon for "dragging its feet over the precarious legal status and lack of protection the Palestinians have been made to endure in the Lebanese territories."

Hundreds of Palestinians from Syria in Lebanon are grappling with deportation concerns and live in a perpetual fear over their families' safety.

In another development, AGPS kept record of the names of 460 Palestinians held in Syrian government jails in a recent campaign to document the number of detainees in war-torn Syria.

Civil Action

The Palestine Charity Commission continues to provide water to displaced families south of Syria as part of a relief campaign launched in early August.

The charity delivered much-needed water supplies to civilians in AlMzeirib town, in Daraa suburbs, after a lake feeding the area has dried out.

AlMzeirib town, home to 1,700 Palestinian families, has come under heavy shelling by Syria's warring parties.

At the same time, Khayrah Ummah Association handed over clothes to at least 500 Palestinian and Syrian orphans in the Turkish cities of Reyhanli, Adana, and Osmaniye.

The move makes part of underway efforts to assist orphans, sick children, and people with special needs from war-ravaged zones.

Palestinians of Syria: August 29, 2017 Statistics:

- At least 3,569 Palestinians, including 462 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.
- 1,631 Palestinian refugees, including 103 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.
- Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,504 days in a row.
- 197 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.
- Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,241 and 1,082 days.
- Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,577 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 330 days.

- Nearly 85,000 Palestinian refugees from Syria fled to Europe until the end of 2016.
- 31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.
- 17,000 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.
- 6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.
- 8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.
- 1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.
