
"Three Palestinian Camps were Bombed, a Child Died at the Yarmouk Camp Due to Siege and Lack of Care"

Recent Updates

Bombing and number of shells were dropped at the Yarmouk camp targeted different places of it with no injuries, while the camp witnessed violent clashes between the Syrian regular army alongside with Palestinian groups loyal to it with groups affiliated to the Syrian opposition forces.

Our correspondent inside the camp reported news about the death of a child from Hamdan family after two days of his birth due to the lack of medical care and medicine and because of the severe shortage of the equipment in the only hospital in the camp, raising the toll of victims who died due to the medical care to 158 victims.

Meanwhile, a mortar shell was dropped at Khan Dannon camp resulted in many injuries amongst the residents who are suffering from hard living crises and shortage of main services, in addition to the lack of water and power for long periods.

Warplanes hovered above Khan Al Sheih camp, while the only road that link the camp with Zakia area was heavily shelled with Shilkla, that is stationed at the battalion"137", while all roads that link the camp with the center of the city are still closed due to the repeated clashes and bombing forcing the residents to go through Zakia-Khan Al Sheih road despite the danger and the repeated shelling and sniping but the residents have to go through this road in order to secure their main needs or to go to the capital for treatment.

A mortar shell was dropped at Al Nairab camp in Aleppo with no damages as it was dropped at an empty land at the vicinity of the camp. In another hand, warplanes targeted the sides of Daraa camp with explosive barrels near Al Sokar Foundation resulted in material damages, after the warplanes targeted Daraa camp, last day, and resulted in massive material damages.

It is mentioned that thousands of the residents had to leave the camp due to the repeated shelling and sniping, since 70% of the camp's buildings were demolished, while the rest of the residents are suffering of the water cut for almost 260 days, prompting them to use water wells to secure their needs. This tragic status coincided with the power cut and the

complete absence of medical services in addition to the stop of the relief organizations to deliver food aids.

Detainees

The Syrian security forces arrested the student "Abdulrahman Nasir Shihab" from Khan Al Sheih camp at Kawkab checkpoint and led him to unknown destination.

It is mentioned that the number of Palestinian refugees in the Syrian prisons, since the beginning of events in Syria, who were documented by the AGPS, has reached 723, while the torture victims number has reached 283 victims.

Releases

The Syrian security forces released the Palestinian refugee "Zahir Isa" from Khan Al Sheih camp after being detained for more than 6 months, noted that he is an employee "cleaning employee" at the UNRWA Services.

Missing People

News reported that the Palestinian Syrian refugee "Mohammed Msheneish" from the Yarmouk camp was missed and lost connection for more than 40 days while he was on his way from Greece to Serbia and Macedonia, noted that the Macedonian border guards arrested him and a number of Palestinian Syrian refugees on 22nd of November 2014 while they were going from Greece to Macedonia on foot.

It is noteworthy that thousands of Palestinian refugees in Syria had to leave their camps due to the bombing, mortar shells, and sniping, as they fled to the neighboring and European countries either by air, sea, or land in spite of the risks of these roads because of the gangs, bandits and traffickers smuggling, in addition to the detention by the European

Traffic Regional Police such as Serbia, Macedonia, Greece, Italy, Hungary, and Bulgaria. They also live in harsh and inhumane conditions and being forced to take the asylum fingerprints, also the denial of the right to ask for residence and asylum in European countries to live with their families.



Turkey

Palestinians of Syria Committee in Turkey distributed heating coal and heaters, that is presented by Al WAfaa European campaign within the program of "Together for Warm Winter". The heaters were distributed to the Displaced Palestinian Syrian families at the Turkish city of Kilis and the surrounding areas.







Egypt

The rest of the Palestinian Syrian refugees in Egypt are living in unclear legal situation in conjunction with the political and security tensions in the country, where the Egyptian security refuses to give them any residencies despite they met the formal requirements for the issuance of those residencies, where the permanently argument, according to many refugees, is that the security approvals have not yet reached," while their suffering increased after the high prices in recent months, in addition to the lack of employment opportunities. Those circumstances forced hundreds of them to risk and ride boats of death to reach Europe seeking for a dignified life and stability, which is lost in Egypt, and mentions that about eight thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees came to Egypt during Mohamed Morsi rule, who allowed the Palestinian Syrian families to enter Egypt, while Egypt is currently prevent them from entering its territory.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics till 30/12/2014

- At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- 2595 Palestinian refugees were documented by the AGPS including 157 women, 283 were killed due to torture, 268 were killed by sniper shot, 84 refugees were field executed, and 984 refugees were killed due to bombing.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 543 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 623 days, water was cut for 113 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 157 victims.
- 80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 14348 refugees in Jordan and 42,000 in Lebanon, according to UNRWA statistics till November 2014.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 445 days respectively.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 415 days respectively.

- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 616 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- **Dara'a Camp**: It is now almost **260** days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Ca mps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.
