#### **Victims**

The young man "Khalid Jihad Tamim" a member of PFGC loyal to the Syrian regime, was killed during the clashes that broke out yesterday in the Yarmouk camp in Damascus. The young man "Ahmed Abdullah Abbas" from Handarat camp was found dead before several days in Khan Touman area in Aleppo, after being killed during the stores battle that broke out between the Syrian opposition forces and the regular army before a year and a half.

It is worth mentioning that Ahmed Abbas is a fighter of Al Baath brigades loyal to the Syrian regime, he has been identified through DNA analysis, where his body was handed over to his family in Aleppo university housing to be buried in AL Neirab camp.

### Recent Updates

The security and the Syrian regular army checkpoints were re-equipped in Al Aedein camp, note that the camp is closed on three sides by the university and university housing fence, where it is connected with the neighborhoods by three roads only, but those roads contains a number of barriers. The members of the Syrian security were re-distributed yesterday inside the campus of the camp and near the walls of the schools where concrete barriers were put there to control the movement. In terms of life aspect, the camp is living a tightening status about the movement of

goods and raw materials to and from the camp, while the checkpoints did not allow the entry of gas a month ago as well as they prevent the entry of building materials and furnishings.

Mean while, crossfire broke out in the Yarmouk camp in Damascus, where sniper sounds were heard in the main street at Yarmouk camp, while the PFGC announced the death of one of its members. It is mentioned that the strict siege imposed on the Yarmouk camp has entered its second year, while the checkpoints of the regular army and groups of the public front prevent the entry of any food or fuel supplies. It is worth mentioning that the siege resulted in the death of 154 victims due to the lack of nutrition and medical care.

On the other hand, warplanes hovered in the sky of AL Nairab camp in Aleppo coincided with violent clashes between the Syrian opposition forces and the regular army in the vicinity of the airport in Al Shiekh Lotfi near Aleppo airport. In addition to the bombing of the surrounding areas which resulted in a state of panic amongst the residents of the camp due to some shrapnel dropped in their houses resulted in material damages.

In terms of living aspect, the residents of the camp are suffering of severe shortage in drinking water for two years, forcing them to share to dig water wells and make it their source of living by selling water at a price of 250 Syrian pounds (\$ 1.5) for the 1000 liters tank, and the continued power outages all over the camp for two years.

Meanwhile, the Action Group correspondent said that a number of Palestinians and youth left the camp to Turkey then to Europe, and confirmed that about 30 youth and a number of families left during the past two days in order to immigrate to Europe countries searching for safety. The correspondent added that this phenomenon has become widespread dramatically among big sector of the residents who have become prefer to ride the boats of death and risk their lives to stay to wait for what will accrue to the situation in Syria.

Sporadic clashes broke out yesterday in the vicinity of Khan Dannoun camp in Damascus city between the Syrian opposition forces and the regular army on the crossing of Taiba town, coincided with violent explosions caused by the bombing of these areas. These clashes resulted in a state of panic and fear among people who suffer from the continuing power, water and telecommunications cut for long periods, in addition to the suffering from the members of the camp checkpoint who harass people and confiscate some of their belongings, and arrest some of them.

#### Arrest

The Syrian security arrested "Mohammed Salayma", 70 years from Al Shajara village in Palestine, he is an official of Baathist partisan group and a former teacher in UNRWA school, where he was arrested as he was leaving Homs city to Aleppo, in the region of AL Setein Street.
