"A Homeland in the Seabed", a Documentary Report for the Action Group that Observes the Sinking of Death Boats in the Mediterranean"



- A Palestinian was killed in Syria.
- Heavy clashes in the vicinity of Handarat camp since days.
- Water returned back in the Yarmouk camp only for two hours after it was cut for about a month.
- Tension state prevailed amongst the residents of Khan Al Sheih camp after the camp was explosive barrels for two days respectively.
- The head of the Public Commission for the Palestinian Refugees Affairs in the Syrian Opposition government visits refugees in Aleppo.

Victims

Audai Ahmed Hawwash from Al Nairab camp in Aleppo was killed in the vicinity of Handarat camp due to ongoing battles in the camp. It is mentioned that Audai is a member of Al Quds brigade, which is affiliated to the Regular Army.

Recent Updates

The studies department at the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria issued, on Wednesday morning on 8th of October 2014, a documentary report titled "A Homeland in the Seabed" where it shows the most prominent drowning accidents of the Palestinian refugees in the Mediterranean Sea during the period between the two summers of 2013-2014.

The report clarifies the circumstances that prompted the Palestinians of Syria and Syrian refugees to get out of Syria through showing some data, numbers and statements which will justify their decision of riding the sea boats. The report introduces a complete explanation supported with forms for the ways that the refugees pass through to reach Europe.

The Report added a testimony of someone who survived form the sinking of the boat on 6th of September 2014; the boat carried about 400 immigrants most of them are form the Gaza Strip residents, only 11 people survived including 8 Palestinians. The report was issued in conjunction with the first anniversary of the sinking of the boat that carried Palestinians of Syria refugees in front of the Italian-Maltese coasts on 11th of October 2013.

On the other hand, heavy battles broke out between the Regular Army alongside with Al Quds brigade and groups of the Free Army. The Regular Army seeks to return back the control over Handarat camp which is under the control of the Opposition. It is mentioned that most of the camp's residents were obliged to leave the camp due to the ongoing

battles between the Regular Army and the Free Army which is ended with complete control of the Free Army over camp.



Handarat camp

In Damascus, the water returned back to the houses of the Yarmouk camp for only two hours in light of its continuous cut for about a month which increased the living crises in the camp, which is for about 15 months where the checkpoints of the Regular Army and the PFGC prevent the entry of the food supplies, medical materials and fuel in addition to the electricity cut for more than a year and a half.

On a different context, a tension state prevailed Khan Al Sheih camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus city after it was exposed to bombing with explosive barrels during the past two days which led to big damage in the residents properties.

In terms of life aspect, the residents are complaining of the continues closure of all roads that connect the camp with the surrounding areas except Zakia road in Khan Al Sheih, the residents are obliged to pass through the Zakia road though the risks due to the clashes between the Regular Army and the Free Army once in a while.

These clashes negatively reflected on the availability of the necessary food supplies where many food supplies ran out of the camp, in addition to the high costs of the other items.
