Victims

Fares Mohamed Al Ghosh and Alaa' Mohamed Hamdan from Abu Nuri neighborhood in Jermana camp died due to the war in Syria. It is referred that a number of Palestinian groups loyal to the Syrian regime and work under its control against the Syrian opposition, many of them were killed in the ongoing battles.

Ramy Baker Abu Ahmed from Al Aedin camp in Homs was killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons after being arrested in 14th of April 2013 in Qatena checkpoint and Also Mohanned Khalifa from the Yarmouk camp was killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons.

Recent Updates

A Group Obedient to the Syrian Opposition Arrests a Number of Palestinian Refugees in Ezaz area while they were trying to reach Turkey. The Action Group knew some detainees names such as Belal omar, Mohamed Anwar Abu Hashem, Ahmed Ayyoub, Mohammed Yousif Qassem and Husam Fran. It is not the first time that the Syrian opposition targets Palestinian refugees, some of the refugees were exposed to detention and some for investigation under the charge of fighting beside the Syrian Regime.

UNRWA continues for the second day to distribute food and health aid to the residents of the Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus yesterday after it was suspended for five days. Some families could enter the Yarmouk camp and their names were registered for the Palestine embassy and the Syrian regime agreed on their entry. Thousands of refugees are still out of the camp and waiting to return to their houses in the camp which is besieged for 416 days.

In Lebanon, The Displaced Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon League issued a statement for the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees and explained the suffering of the Palestinian refugees in Lebanon in addition to what they live from suffering and risks in Syria where the statement demands to hand over the file of the Palestinian refugees to the UNHCR.

In Turkey, the Palestinian refugees who ran away from the war in Syria to the Turkish border live in tents in KLS Shelter Center where the tents don't protect them from the heat of the day or the cold of the night. It is mentioned that dozens of Palestinian families left to Turkey though they were not allowed to enter Turkey legally. The Turkish embassies are not issuing visas for the Palestinians of Syria without giving any excuses.

In Tunisia, the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria got news about arresting about 200 Palestinian and Syrian refugees in Ben Gardane south of Tunisia under the charge of illegal immigration.
